I have laid before the Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury Mr. Fiddes' letter of the 21st ultimo (21967/1911) and the accompanying copy of a despatch from the Governor of the East Africa Protectorate on the subject of the prospects of the export of wheat from the Protectorate.

In reply I am to request you to inform Mr. Secretary Harcourt that, in the circumstances represented, My Lords approve Sir P. Girouard's recommendation that the same railway rates should be charged for wheat as have already been conceded for maize and beans under the sanction of Treasury letters No. 1353/10 of the 29th of January 1910 and No. 5568/10 of the 24th of March 1910 respectively.
