I have the honour to acknowledge the receipt of your despatch No. 1046 of the 9th. of December, 1913 on the subject of "The Abuse of Opiates Prevention Ordinance, 1913" and, with reference to paragraph 2, to state that the term "Medical Practitioner" is already defined in Section 2 of the Ordinance as meaning a duly qualified Medical Practitioner.

2. The term would, therefore, appear to be brought within the definition in Section 13 of "The Medical Practitioners and Dentists Ordinance, 1910".
