Dear Mr. Perkins,

In continuation of my letter of the 31st March I write to say that I have now received from the Governor of the East Africa Protectorate a reply to the effect that there is no reason for alarm on the part of the Uasin Gishu settlers, no need for special measures for their protection against a native rising.
