Sir,

I have the honour to refer to my despatch No. 393 of the 30th of June and to inform you that Mrs. H.S. Bezuidenhout, widow of the late Corporal J.M. Bezuidenhout, East Africa Transport Corps, re-married on the 18th ultimo.

2. She does not propose to claim the gratuity to which she is entitled under Army Order 213 of 1915; consequently the pension granted to her will be reduced by 10^s/- per week as from the date of her re-marriage.

The pension in respect of her three children will, however, continue to be paid in accordance with paragraph 4 of Army Order 213.
