I have the honour to acknowledge the receipt of your cypher telegram dated the 30th June conveying your approval of steps being taken as soon as possible to acquire for Government the land suggested by Mr. Hobley in the Mtongwe and Likoni blocks.

2. After consideration of the matter in my Executive Council, I have caused arrangements to be made for the immediate survey of the land in question, and have asked Mr. Hobley to submit a report as to the extent to which land can be acquired by private treaty. On receipt of Mr. Hobley's report, the manner in which the remainder of the area can be acquired will be considered.

3. A further report will be sent in due course and, in the meantime, every precaution is being taken to prevent the contemplated acquisition becoming known.
