I am to inform you, in reply to your letter received on the 16th of May, that the Council of the E.A.P. has consented to ~~grant~~ you an extension of time for two months from the 1st of June next for the payment of the survey fees and deposit in connection with the fibre concession on Teava which it is proposed to grant you ~~but he adds that no further extension is allowed.~~


It is proposed that the concession should be 50 sq. miles in extent, that the term of lease should be 25 years, that the rent should be £50 a year, and that ~~£5,000~~ it should be stipulated that £5,000 should be expended on the property within five years.
