Please see 17841/19. It is the procedure of the M.P. to continue the award at the old rate pending a decision as to the new rate (vide para 3 of M.P. letter of 26.11.18 or 3.6.19/19 - I have verified this by phone). We made the award at 22/9 a week commencing from the end of Sept 1919 (17841/19). We asked the M.P. on 9.10 (17841/19) and 26.9.19 (53501/19) the date on the letter on the latter paper viz. 13.9.19 seems incorrect in view of the letter on 17.8.19/19.
