Petain seems to have thought that by being servile to Germany he was doing the friendship of Germany. He has paid a heavy price and has not yet succeeded in saving his country. He has only lost it. He has been humiliated and he has no more to offer.
It is foolish to think that they are not very grateful. Marshal Petain and M. Laval—they did not return in thanksgiving to the French. The continued presence of Italy are helping Germany and abuse or the white hand of the wretched Petain and the wretched of his deputy, Laval. The Marshal is a traitor and a scoundrel. The Foreign Minister, M. Baudouin, is described as revealing a remarkable duplicity. M. Baudouin is intended to having given an interview to the Associated Press in which he said that the future form of government in France would tend more to the American system than to any other. The American may not relish the comparison, but the Germans are even more resentful of it.

No Quota Restrictions

Although the British Government is not yet ready to announce the sending of children overseas, it does not mean that the whole scheme is done with. To help with the future migration of children, the United States have removed the quota on immigrants so far as children are concerned.

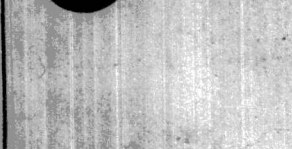

The Royal Air Force have again successfully attacked military objectives in Germany, Holland and Northern France. The weather was against them and they had to fight through thick clouds. They had to circle round for some time to make up their minds because of landing fog.

They dropped four and a half tons of bombs direct on an oil plant at Hamburg; factories in the Ruhr; aircraft parks at another place and goods yards at Hamm and Osnabrueck.

They also attacked Dutch aerodromes and a harbour on the Dutch coast where warehouses were left in a state of confusion.

Other of our aircraft attacked an enemy aerodrome in France and bombed a concentration of barges near the Belgian frontier (one of our planes is missing) (Reuter).

SPECIAL COURTS IF BRITAIN IS INVADED

July 11.
The Emergency Powers Bill enabling the Government to set up special regional courts in case of invasion has been the focus of Communist yesterday.

Sir John Anderson, the Minister for Home Security, said the object of the Bill was to avoid the need for setting up Military courts to deal with civilians. In the case of an attempted invasion it might be necessary to have simplified procedure for offences of a military character. These courts would have no juries and there would be no appeal from their decisions, except in cases where the death penalty was imposed when an appeal might be made to the Home Secretary.

Sentences of death would be imposed for looting or forcing one's way past a military picket.

There would be no right of appeal from the Bill, largely on the grounds that in full powers ought to be set out and not to be inserted afterwards by regulations. The general feeling was that the Bill was too vague. It was thought that although the present Government could be trusted not to use its wide powers unjustly, later Governments might be tempted to do so.

Sir John Anderson said that the Bill would be amended to show how it was proposed to use the powers it gave.

The Minister's speech today was mainly concerned with the new Bill.

The Bill is commended by many of the papers but they also state that it is proposed to be revised and watched by Parliament.

The Hansard Committee stress that changes of this kind, however great their urgency, must not be imposed upon the House of Commons until the Government know they amount to it.

The Daily Telegraph says the powers are drastic and require careful debate in Parliament.

The Daily Mail says its members would have to be very carefully watched by the House of Commons and the public. (Reuter).

EARL KILLED IN ACTION

London, July 11.
The Earl of Coventry, who was a lieutenant in the Westssex Regiment and was reported missing in action in the Netherlands, has been killed in action. (Reuter).

July 11.
