Letters for the Troops

The East African Standard continues to receive an increasing number of complaints from the public, particularly from relatives of men in the Forces, regarding the Army Postal Service. The burden of these complaints is that there is a serious delay in the handling of mail for the troops. Typical letters from correspondents are published today and in one there is quoted an instance of a telegram accepted by the authorities at urgent rates and delivered some days later through the Army Postal Service, as a letter.

We are prepared to make every sort of allowance for the difficulties which we must meet in the case of an urgent telegram—but we do suggest that if even half the complaints we receive are warranted there should be a reorganisation of the A.P.S. with a view to speeding up the delivery of the mail for the troops. Organized militaries should be asked to review the whole field of postal services for the Forces, including the handling of parcels and the collection of money by the Post Office.

Some of the complaints have been passed on through the appropriate channels in order that a reply or explanation might be given but we must confess that these efforts have not been fruitful in the light of results and we have also been told that members of the public who made complaints direct to the Postmaster-General have been unable to get very much satisfaction.

We need hardly stress the point that the regular delivery of mail is one of the important factors in preserving contentment of mind among the troops. If there are long and unexplained gaps in the receipt of letters both the man and his family begin to worry, probably unduly but naturally enough. Let us admit at once that the job of the Army Postal Service is always difficult. The Civil Department hands over army mail without delay and there the responsibility of the Postmaster General apparently ends. After that the problem is complicated by troop movements, by the change of address, by the other demands upon transport, by commodity and by a number of other things in the life of the staff of the A.P.S. unobtainable. They cannot over work fast enough to satisfy every body and they are not responsible for delays which have nothing to do with them at all.

VOLUNTARY SYSTEM FOR REGISTERING DOMESTIC SERVANTS

PROTECTING SERVANTS AND EMPLOYERS

A UNANIMOUS recommendation that the registration of all domestic servants in Kenya should be placed on a voluntary basis has been made by a Special Committee of Governmental Departments with this question.

This committee was appointed in December last year to consider the registration of Domestic Servants Ordinance, 1934 and to make recommendations for the improvement of the existing system, or for the substitution of another system to suit the purposes of that Ordinance.

In the statement of the Provincial Commissioner of the Rift Valley Province (Mr. E. O. V. Hodges), at a meeting of the Rift Valley Council, on July 17, the Committee held that it was desirable to make the registration of Domestic Servants Ordinance, 1934, and to make recommendations for the improvement of the existing system, or for the substitution of another system to suit the purposes of that Ordinance.

The committee had also considered evidence and memoranda submitted from various official sources, from Associations and public bodies, many European employers and a number of Africans.

At the outset it was emphasized that the duty of the Committee was the consideration of the Ordinance in hand without reference to the proceedings of previous committees.

It was further stressed that there must be the Ordinance and a complete abolition of registration of domestic servants were within the committee's terms of reference.

The committee took the purpose of the Ordinance to be (a) to establish the position of servants of good character; (b) to identify undesirable persons; and (c) to prevent the unwitting employment in positions of trust of persons of known criminal history.

The Ordinance, it was emphasized, was not intended to have reference to a servant of efficiency, but only to moral character.

The report of the committee which mentions, inter alia, that no communication whatever was received from any member of the African community—refers largely to the provisions of the existing Ordinance and outlines its procedure.

The majority of persons submitting memoranda to the committee expressed appreciation of the Ordinance since to the whole Colony, but enough evidence of opposition was received from any members of the community that it would meet with little of objection sufficient to seriously impair the effectiveness of the measure.

The conclusion arrived at was that the proposed law is a commendable application of the Ordinance was based on a sound basis, but that control was insufficient and some of the provisions of the Ordinance were in part inadequate, other than the suggestions of complete application of the spirit of the measure.

The committee was unanimous that the present Ordinance had not been applied in an important degree.

Working with the various heads under which the measure had been wholly or partially implemented, the committee expressed the view that:

(a) Control was inadequate and that considerable evidence existed

Norwegian ships, totaling four and a half million tons, which still continue the struggle against Germany, are now being defensively used.

Many are now being used, not only for defence against air, but also for the carriage of munitions. Many of these ships will be manned by the crews of merchantmen, some of whom have served in the Norwegian Navy under the operational flag.

The Norwegian shipping law available in Britain includes 17,000 tons of trucks forming one of the most valuable tanker fleets in the world.—(Reuter.)
