## EARTHQUAKE IN NORTH JAPAN

### Hundreds of deaths feared

### TIDAL WAVES TAKE TOLL IN COASTAL VILLAGES

A catastrophic and a series of giant tidal waves yesterday wrought havoc in Northern Japan, bringing in their wake a mounting toll of death and destruction. By late afternoon over 100 deaths had been reported. Many hundreds more are feared.

The people of Kushiro, northern island of Hokkaido, had been worst hit, with its main town Kushiro badly damaged. One village near the town reported that 400 houses had been washed away and another village said that 90 of its inhabitants had been killed. In Kushiro it was a town of nearly 90,000 people—the firm was raging by late afternoon.

The people of Kushiro watched the earthquake shake down windows and stone buildings, spreading the firm. First reports from the city put the number of dead at 13. At sea, fishing boats were overturned by 30-foot tidal waves.

As soon as the first shocks were felt, American military authorities put into operation the emergency services reserved for a major disaster.

These authorities reported that about 100,000 people in the northern part of Hokkaido were evacuated for heavy seas.

In some places water was inundated four feet deep and a trunk railway is reported to have been inundated.

### Ten-foot waves

Coastal stations had reported the arrival of a "strong" earthquake breaking sea in Aomori, Honshu. The earthquake was reported at the station, said the Japanese Broadcasting Corporation, which was the lightest in the series.

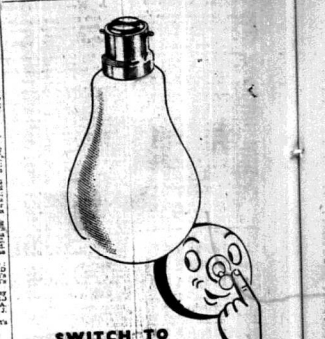

**BRITISH DEFICIT LAST MONTH WAS THE LOWEST SINCE JUNE**

Britain's losses in gold and dollar reserves both in Europe and the United States have been cut sharply for the first time in several London.

Preliminary indications are that Britain's and the sterling area's deficit in the European Payments Union was slashed from 151 million dollars in January to about 65 million in February.

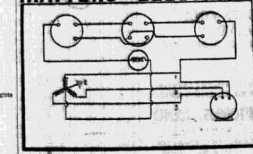

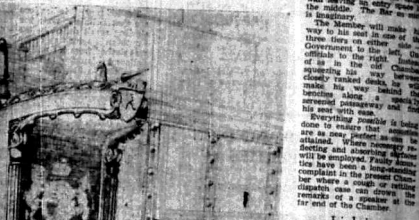
THE chamber which will house Kenya's new Legislature in about 15 months time will be a replica of the British House of Commons.

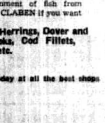

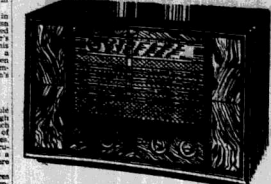

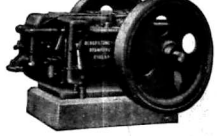
