INCONVENIENCE, BUT NOT HARDSHIP, WILL RESULT

East Africa's plans as part of the programme to save the £ and avert the progressive deterioration in the sterling area balance of payments position are announced today. Full details of the proposals which have been designed to meet imports from the West, covering areas are published on page 7.

Flour grates are closed at Tignes

The main gates of the dam in France's new heavy-hydroelectric scheme have been closed, but the 100 villagers of the tiny village of Tignes are still standing fast.

The village stands on the slopes of the Savoie mountain which will be flooded by the scheme. Already a lake about 400 yards long has formed in the basin of the valley, and three months ago the village church was in the water. The lake has now risen to a level of 100 feet above the village.

The Tignes rebels have said they will not be flooded by the scheme. They stand in a protest against the Government's plan to compensate them for the loss of their homes.

The villagers have been clearing the lake and earth from the church graveyard, preparatory to the removal of the remains to the village school where the services of the French Service Police had to be performed. The lake has now risen to a level of 100 feet above the village.

The Prefect of Savoie, M. J. P. Audebert, accompanied a strong force of police to the village last week. He said the lake was not so dangerous as the rebels had been told. He said that M. Justin Raymond would give them an allowance of 100 francs for the removal of their homes and the cost of their new ones.

Kenya's fishing industry during the last few years has threatened to die. The fishery can now sell all the fish they catch at a price between 40 and 50 cents a lb. reported Mr. Hugh Copley, Kenya's Fish Warden.

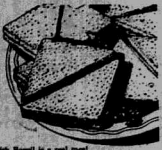

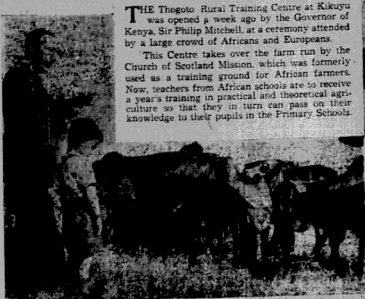

Now, teachers from African schools are to receive a year's training in practical and theoretical agriculture so that they in turn can pass on their knowledge to their pupils in the Primary Schools.

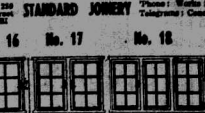

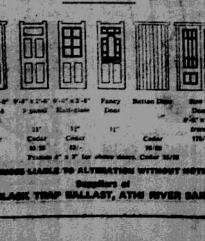

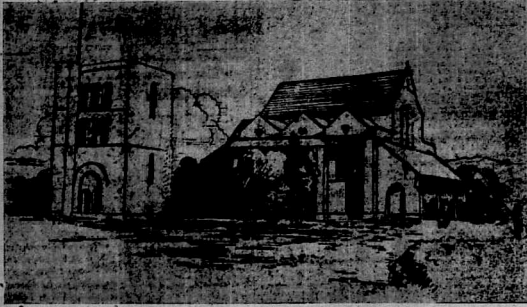

The Cathedral of the Highlands will be consecrated today



TODAY, Friday March 21, will go down in the history of the Diocese of Mombasa and the Colony of Kenya as the climax of the work of 35 years.

All Saints Cathedral, popularly known as the Cathedral of the Highlands, of which the first foundation stone was laid in 1917, is now at last completed. The building will be solemnly consecrated by the Bishop of the Diocese at 3.30 this evening.

It is calculated that the cost of the whole building over the years, together with the furnishings, so far given, will have been not less than £250,000, of which some £20,000 has been given by the people of Kenya since the recent Appeal was launched in October, 1949.

The Cathedral is being opened entirely free of debt, though a sum of some £4,000 will still be needed to cover the cost of the removal of the organ console and the electrifying of the organ. This work cannot be carried out for two years.

The completed building, as seen in the accompanying pictures, and as viewed from Delamere Avenue, is now a handsome addition to the architecture of Mombasa. Having been for so many years in an incomplete state, it now stands with its two towers in fine proportion, the new chancel being considerably more attractive than the original nave.

The length of the building is 120 feet from the west door to the altar, with a further extension beyond containing the Chapter House.

The latter is an octagonal room paneled in camphor, with a window seat running round, and an octagonal table in the centre. It will be used exclusively for meetings of the Cathedral Chapter and Council.

These pictures show the different stages in the building of the Cathedral over the years. In the sketch above the building is seen as it was in 1917. Below, a photograph, which was called "The Unfinished Tomb," shows the Cathedral as it stood from 1924 until 1949, while top right, it is seen as it stands today. The extent of the most recent additions can be clearly studied from the two last-mentioned pictures.



The picture on the immediate left was taken at the open air service held in July, 1942, in rain God's blessing before the work of extension began. Immediately above it the Bishop of Mombasa, the Rt. Rev. R. Crabbe, is seen giving the blessing at the ceremony of the laying of the foundation stone by the Governor, Sir Philip Mitchell, in October, 1948. On the right, the Governor tells the Bishop, after the launching of the appeal for £250,000, that he believes it will certainly be raised before long.

The photographs below show the new chancel, with its hammer-beam roof, and the rose window presented by Mrs. Violet Clark, of Nairobi in memory of her husband. The two small windows in the bottom left picture were presented, one anonymously, and one by Limuru Girls' School.
