NEW ELECTRIC POWER SUPPLY CONTROL

Fewer cuts for water-heaters

A NEW and improved method of supply control, which it is hoped will be put into operation by the end of the year, will enable the East Africa Power and Lighting Company to leave all domestic water-heater connected throughout the day, except for short periods not likely to exceed a total of six hours over the peak period.




