Egypt in the throes of a money crisis

EGYPT has experienced her most startling economic crisis in the history of the country since the 1930s with nearly eight months to go before she can expect relief from her desperate balance sheet in London.

The Egyptian Government has recently received from London a loan of £10 million for the purpose of covering the year's deficit. This loan has already been drawn upon to the extent of £2 million.

Facing the most severe economic crisis in her history, Egypt is now trying to secure a further loan of £10 million in the sterling area in order to meet her requirements for the coming year.

The Government has also issued a short-term loan of £2 million to cover part of Egypt's dollar deficit before being able to raise the balance of the loan.

Stored cotton

The dollar fund now stands at £10 million. The year's cotton stocks still stand in excess of requirements in order to meet the needs of the dollar area.

The situation is so serious that the Egyptian Government has been applying to the Bank for a loan of £10 million to cover the deficit.

It is estimated that the dollar fund will be exhausted by the end of the year.
