PRESIDENT TRUMAN SEES THRESHOLD OF NEW AGE

PRESIDENT TRUMAN took part on Saturday at Georgetown, in a ceremony in which he laid the keel for what the United States hopes will be the world's first atomic-engine submarine.

The vessel, the *Nautilus*, when completed, is expected to be the first of its kind, but there has been speculation that it may be experimentally run on similar lines.

Speaking at the ceremony, Mr. Truman said that even were United States scientists had been working for five years to the point of harnessing the atomic power of the atom bomb, he would not have hesitated to try to harness it.

A PLAN whereby leprosy may be completely eradicated on the islands of Zanzibar and Pemba has been reported by the East African Leprologist, Dr. Ross Jones. In a report submitted to his Highness the Sultan of Zanzibar, Dr. Jones advocates greater use of the drug known as DDE (Diaminodiphenyl Sulphonate) which has already arrested the course of the disease in many cases and, in some, has resulted in a complete cure.




