En route to America

BABY PRINCE, NOW KING, TO RETURN AFTER SEVEN YEARS

KING FAROUK left Egypt at six o'clock on Saturday evening with Queen Nazam after giving up the throne at the demand of the King. With them was their 12-year-old son, Prince Ahmed Fouad, in whose name the King has abdicated. His two eldest daughters by his first wife, Farah, were also on board the royal yacht Marjaneh.

They were believed to be bound for the Italian port of Genoa, from where they may fly to Alexandria Royal Jet. The King boarded the Royal Standard, bound for London, at the former Monarch. Tears were streamed down the face of the bodyguard.

A military band played the Egyptian National Anthem as an Egyptian airplane took the last salute.

Almost simultaneously the British Foreign Office announced that British troops would make "certain preliminary movements" in view of the unsettled position in Egypt.

EMILY ZATOPK of Czechoslovakia was crowned the world's greatest long-distance runner ever at Harington on Sunday, finishing off powerfully to the very end and was runner of the year in Olympic record time covering the 26 1/2 miles in two hours 10 1/2 minutes and the 5,000 metres race.

No runner ever before has come first in all three races in an Olympiad.

Zatopk's leading finish, striding his head as he traversed the 26 1/2 miles of the British Empire Course of Argentina. That was the first time since the days of the great runner who had had a terrific record in the 100 and 200 metres half-marathon and the 5000 metres race.

The first of his three triumphs came in the 5,000 metres race, when he won by a margin of 10 1/2 seconds over the runner-up, the Japanese Kito, who was second.

BIG JUMP IN INCOME TAX COLLECTION

Most of increase from Kenya

INCOME TAX collected in Kenya last year is estimated at £2,520,000, according to the annual report of the East African Income Tax Department just published. Of this total £2,000,000 would come from Kenya, £1,900,000 from Tanganyika, £200,000 from Uganda and £100,000 from Zanzibar. It is calculated that the 1950 estimate total was £1,610,000, with £1,490,000 from Kenya, £1,380,000 from Tanganyika, £480,000 from Uganda and £170,000 from Zanzibar. The income tax collections during last year were £1,400,000, though, a rise of 50 per cent. To reach such a high estimate total tax was 15 per cent of the total income of £9,300,000 in 1950 the figure was 43 cents and 52 per cent. The estimated total of the Department last year was £1,810,000.

NOTES ON FOREST ENTOMOLOGY Beetle Borers In Seasoned Wood
