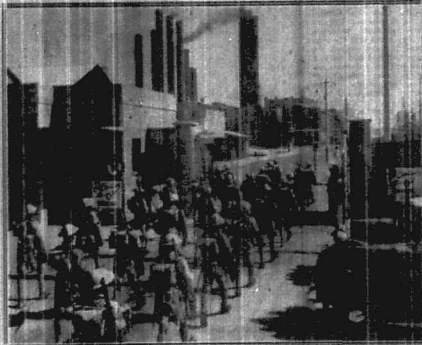

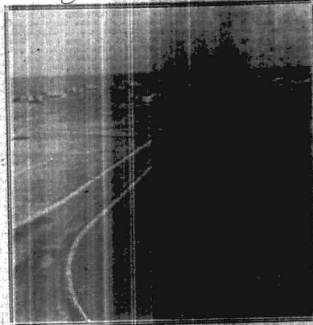

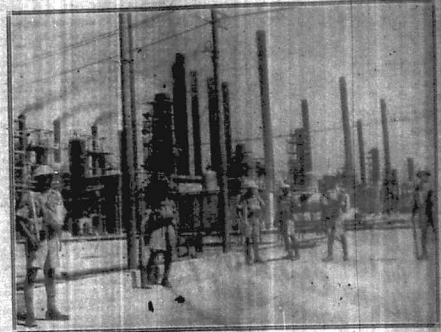
THE GREAT OIL REFINERY OF ARADIAN ON THE PERSIAN GULF



Indian troops entering the main gates of the oil refinery on the island of Aradjan at the head of the Persian Gulf.



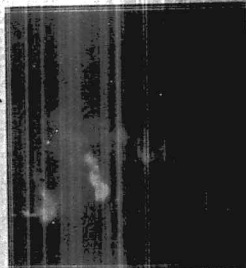
The village of Kirku where oilfield employees live.



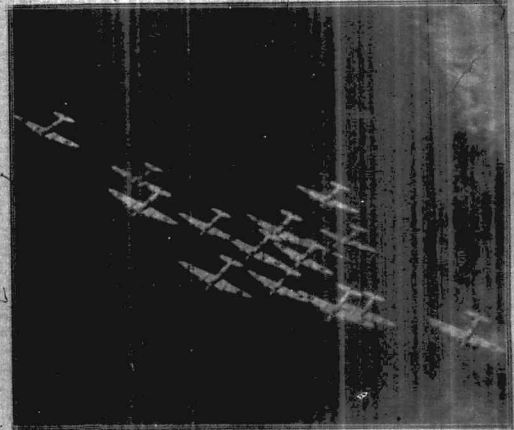
Indian riflemen on guard at the oil refinery at Aradjan, which belongs to the Anglo Iranian Oil Company.



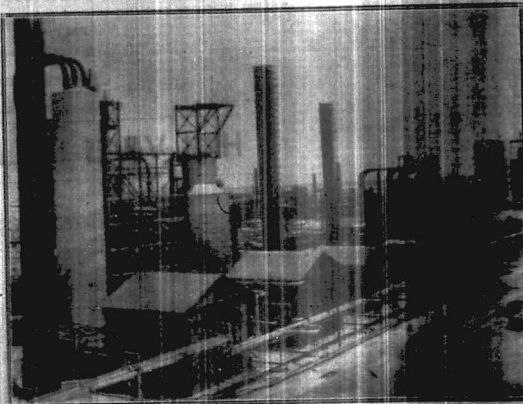

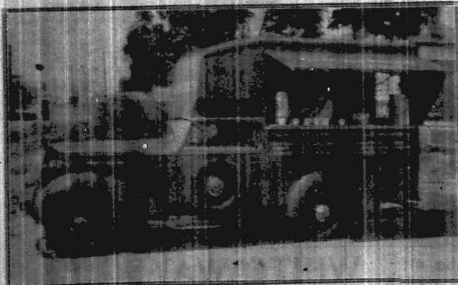
General view of the Oilfields at night



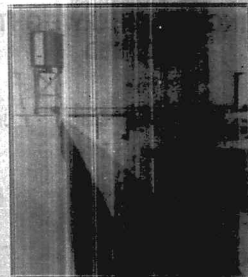
Glenn Martin Maryland bombers of the South African Air Force in "tight box" formation leaving to raid enemy harbours in North Africa.



A general view of the largest refinery in the world at Aradjan. The refinery was functioning normally 24 hours after the entry of British troops.

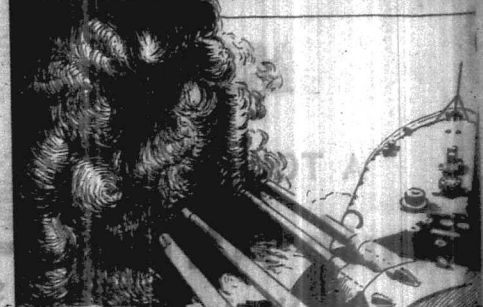

RESOLUTIONS AT NAKURU MEETING

AFTER several hours, frank discussion of the labour situation in Kenya on Friday ended with the Government led by the Governor to make a war effort the African community should stand by production of more labour.

That this meeting is of the opinion that the task of a native employed on a farm should regard the fair output of an average native during an eight-hour day and requests Government to instruct its Administrative and Labour Officers to impress upon native farm employers that this is their duty and to draw up by a Committee of employers in each district, and approved by the Labour Commissioner, a list of standards which should be observed and that Government should make the necessary arrangements to enforce these standards on native farms as decided on this day.

That as proposed action in dealing with minor offences and disciplinary matters of native labour should be referred to the increasing subordination of the Government by requests to appear before the Labour Commissioner of the District, immediately with limited special powers, and to make decisions which are made before them in their own districts.
In the course of the meeting Lord Francis Scott revealed that Government had made arrangements to disband native military contingents for a period of two months, from 1st July to the following resolution was carried:
That when requested military contingents, Government be requested to go into the whole question to ensure that labour is available to run the country for some time.
In order to solve many matters that were likely to become the subjects of resolutions, the following resolution was carried:
That Government be requested to appoint a small committee to visit various districts in order to investigate the numerous difficulties in connection with the employment of labour and to make recommendations to Government.
Accepted act of resolutions at the meeting decided to elect two representatives of the farmers and Mr. Will Ryan were appointed.
At the close of the meeting the Chairman thanked the Director of Agriculture, the Provincial Labour Officer, Lord Francis Scott, Major Cavendish, and the members of the Native Commissioner for their attendance at the meeting.
Mr. Volny, a farmer who congratulated had done the meeting, moved a vote of thanks to the Government officials who had attended.

Verbi's Evidence

On his way out Dr. Murovet saw Mrs. Corriam and gave a verbal message from her to Mrs. Verbi on his return to Wau.

Then Dr. Murovet went to Wau by car on the following morning Sunday, July 27. He drove a double deck with his new daughter Mary and an ayah. The subsequent interview between the doctor and his wife in the month house lasted between five and fifteen minutes. Later Mrs. Verbi saw a woman who it transpired was the sold him went to look for Verbi and persuasively urged him to half a mile from the road walking away from Wau at a very fast pace. He just left her behind.

News At A Penny A Word

Anything which encourages the presentation of a clearer and fuller picture of the British Empire to Great Britain and of Great Britain to the Empire merits full support. 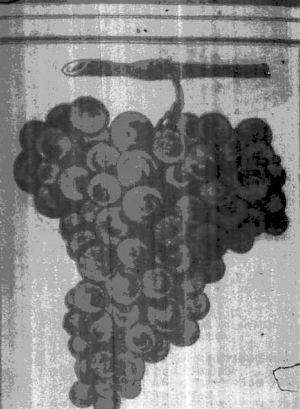


