Independent State For Arabs and Jews In 10 Years

JEWISH IMMIGRATION TO STOP AFTER 5 YEARS

The British Government's policy for Palestine was issued as a White Paper on Wednesday night. Its main points may be summarized thus:

- 1. An independent Palestine State is to be established in 10 years with Jews and Arabs sharing in the Government.
2. Jewish immigrants are to be limited to 75,000 for the next five years. Immigration of Jews will then stop unless the Arabs agree to its continuance.
3. The High Commissioner will forthwith prohibit further land sales in certain areas and restrict and limit sales in other areas.

The statement of the Government's policy for Palestine, issued last evening, contains the declaration that the objective of the Government is to establish an independent State in Palestine within 10 years of the date of the Government's declaration. The Government will provide the necessary financial assistance for the establishment of the State. 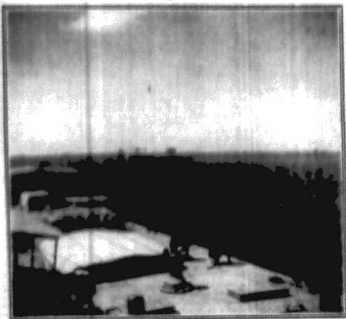

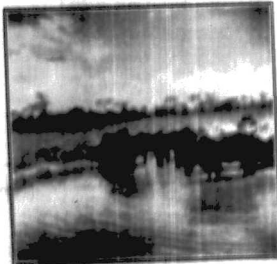

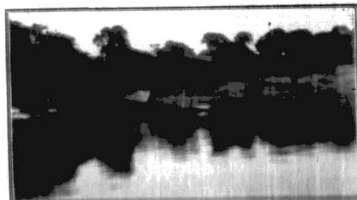

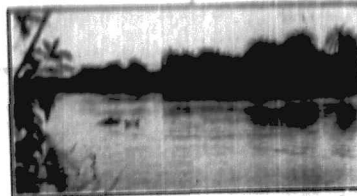

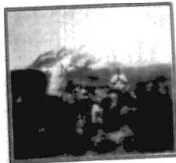
