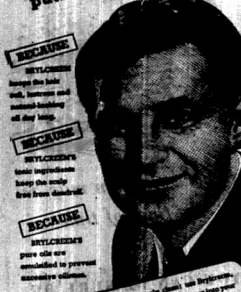

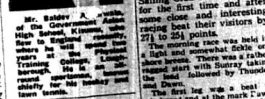

DROUGHT in the Kajiado District of the Masai Reserve, which has already widespread, a loss of stock has been aggravated by the failure of several important boreholes.

LABOUR BOARD CHANGES

Proposals being circulated in Tanganyika's Northern Province

COMPULSORY membership of the Northern Province Labour Utilization Board will be restricted to agricultural employers with 20 or more employees under the re-organization of the Board approved by the Government Council. Any other Northern Province employers can opt to become registered members if they wish but, having done so, will be permitted to withdraw only after giving a year's notice.

The proposals, now being circulated, follow two years of debate, and have been drafted in accordance with the Government's policy to establish it.

The reorganization proposals include changes in the commercial employers' board, which will be replaced by a board of 10 members, 5 of whom will be representatives of the employers. The new board will be formed by the Government on January 1, 1956. At present, the board consists of two employers' representatives, one representative of the Government, and four elected members. The chairman will be elected by the board members.

Being prepared

Three new refineries being built in India

THREE oil refineries now under construction in India will together have the capacity to handle 3,710,000 long tons of crude oil a year, yielding 147,000,000 gallons of petrol and 125,400,000 gallons of paraffin. Two of the refineries are being set up in Bombay by the American Standard Vacuum Company and the British Burma Shell. The third is being built on India's east coast at Visakhapatnam, by Caltex (American) and Indian Oil Corporation.

The refineries, which are being built in full operation, will meet a little over 50 per cent of the country's demand for petrol and a little less than half the demand for paraffin.
