Four Lincolns bomb forest hideouts





THE STUDIOS OF THE FORCES' RADIO

In a wooden hut, standing in a field just off the beginning of Lower Kabete Road, Nairobi, is there a housed what must be one of the largest collections of gramophone records in East Africa. It is added to those already neatly filed on the shelves which line the room.

As you may have guessed they belong to the Forces Broadcasting Service and they range from noble effects to a kilder special recording of the opera *Gianni Schicchi* which plays for 25 minutes.

It is so B.B.C. with impressive buildings and uniformed communicationists, this broadcasting station too—their radio entertainment. It is housed like a poor relation of the great British Broadcasting Corporation, in a wooden hut—a wooden hut for the library and a wooden hut somewhat smaller for the office. The office are in a Nansen hut.

Let's begin in the library where Mrs. Neill thanks to an efficient card index system can lay her hands on anything you ask for if it happens to be there. What it usually is. Bill Crosby, for instance, has a mass of cassettes in the index drawer.

The records come from several different sources and are of all types. There are, first and foremost, the B.B.C. transmissions, some of which can be used for a longer where there but all of which have to be changed three years from the date of recording in the B.B.C. Then there are records supplied by commercial firms, by the War Office, by the United States International Service and long-playing records bought locally with money sent from the War Office for the purpose.


The Service, incidentally, has no real source of income and is financed entirely from War Office funds. So, unless you happen to be in uniform you are in fact a "guest" listener.

As I said, there are all manner of recording: tender plays, songs, operas, stage effects and so this kicked me most—what they call "mood music." These records arrive with a written description of what the music is intended to imply and they are used to create atmosphere. Or, in other words, to put the listener "in the mood."

There are two studios at the station—one for continuity and one for feature programmes—with the control room sandwiched in between the two. From either studio you can look into the control room through plate glass windows which must make the control operators feel rather like a fish in an aquarium.

I think most people are sufficiently familiar with radio studios to know how they work—the microphones, sound-proofed walls, turntables and control panels with a variety of knobs and switches. Things I hadn't realized were that:

If he needs to, the announcer can talk through the microphone in the control room while a programme is on the air without the conversation going on the air at the same time that the announcer listens to another recording at the same time as one is going out.

This, for instance, he has to do if he wants to know the exact spot at which to start playing a second record as soon as the first one is finished. And to help him do this he has an "on-call" room as at a groove locator.

While the first record is going out over the air, he listens through headphones to the second record, the spot at which he reaches the spot at which he reaches the groove locator lifts the placard and then it is copied in the exact position and played to him, which enables him to be very precise in the required music state.

What it amounts to is that you can have an undisturbed record with all start and stop with absolute smoothness.


Portrait of Sir Evelyn Baring, Secretary of State for the Colonies.




