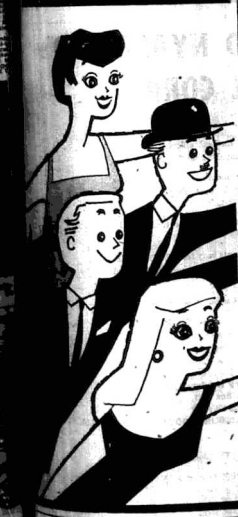

U.S. steps up exports to Kenya

20 PER CENT RISE IN FIRST QUARTER

WITH an increase of nearly 20 per cent in its exports to Kenya in the first quarter of this year, the United States has set a new record for its trade with the East African state.

The value of the United States' exports to Kenya rose to £1,642,000 in the first quarter of 1960 to £1,978,000 in the first quarter of this year—a comprising nearly seven per cent increase.

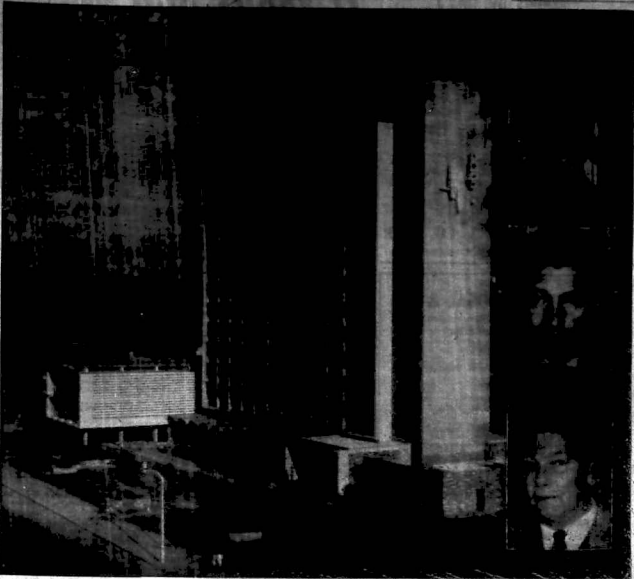
TO OPEN BUILDING

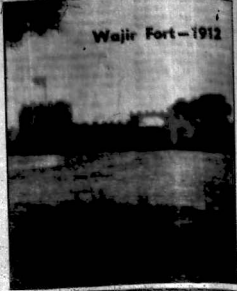

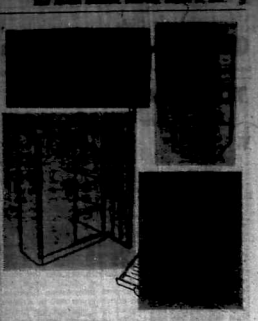

The crowd rushed towards it and the driver had to stop with difficulty in negotiating the gateway to the house.

Dozens of reporters in the doorway of his house, Kenya said he was not bitter about his imprisonment because he knew his cause was just. He continued: "I regard every body as my friend. You know the Commandment—'Love thy neighbour as thyself'. My neighbour is my neighbour."
