Rich deposits of brown coal found in South India

In an obscure village in South India, geologists have discovered what they believe to be the richest deposit of lignite (brown coal) in Asia. Buried 200 feet in Madras State is an estimated 2,000,000,000 tons of this vital industrial fuel.

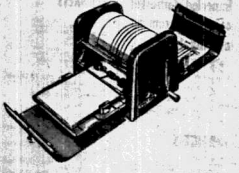

LAST year the Uganda Development Corporation, Ltd., has made a net profit of £69,432, which has been carried forward as an unappropriated revenue reserve. The figure is given in the corporation's annual report and accounts which were tabled in Uganda Legislative Council yesterday.

Mr. J. T. Simpson, the chairman, begins his report by stating that he regards the proper staffing of any business concern as the major contribution to its success.

"The application of capital and the appointment of boards to manage the business are two factors which have not been given sufficient weight in the past," Mr. Simpson said, "but it is the ability, enthusiasm, and what is known as the 'know-how' of the staff, which is the key to the corporation's adaptability to the present and the future conditions—the exercise of great initiative and the willingness to devote much energy to the training of staff."

High-calibre staff

The corporation, he stated, is building up a staff of the high calibre required and the directors record their appreciation of the personal efforts of each individual employed by most of the departments.
