# Insects and the economics of agriculture

It is quite true that "big flies" have little flies. . . . That much was evident from the facts which Dr. G. Salt, the distinguished entomologist of Cambridge University, revealed this week to the Nairobi Scientific and Philosophical Society.

Latest research work carried out by the staff of the East Africa Agricultural Research Organisation, of agriculture in this country. In the words of the speaker, who has been carrying out research under the wing of the Colonial Office, "the pay-off of the insect has stepped into the economy of our agriculture."

Dr. Salt explained that the latest principle of insect control is to deliberately introduce to the crop, an insect parasite which will destroy the pests which feed on coffee, cotton or other plantations, and which have been with the insect and other pests.

Microscopic  
 The 14th volume of a new 100 species of insect parasites of a certain group that Dr. Salt's experiments were concerned. These parasites feed on plants and kill them. This is a type of ichneumonid fly which would attack a certain type of pest.

One species, the Trypanosoma, which would kill one or four could be used, and it is possible to use microscopic parasites, but smaller species, even smaller parasites, live on even smaller parasites. Yes, truly, the flies have little flies.

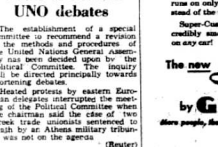
