TANGANYIKA SEEKS SWEDISH HELP TO BUILD UP ROAD SYSTEM

DR. NYERERE has asked Swedish leaders for help in building up Tanganyika's manufacturing sector, according to Swedish sources. At a meeting yesterday in the Prime Minister, Mr. Tage Erlander, and the Foreign Minister, Mr. Folke Bernadotte, Dr. Nyerere said his country needed roads, railways and aircraft so as to develop the country's wealth.

The Swedish Ministers did not make any immediate promises of aid. Sweden is already collaborating with the Government in building health centres and agricultural schools in Tanganyika.

Dr. Nyerere also said that Sweden had not yet built roads in Tanganyika, with the result that only one per cent of the country's total industrial production came from its own industry.

It was being indicated that he was going to press for more private foreign investment, particularly in the road and air transport sectors.





STANDARD INTERRIOR REPORTERS LONDON.—The first full working session of the Kenya committee was held in private at Lancaster House, the following day, and was devoted to a discussion of the proposals for citizenship which were issued last night.

The committee, which is headed by the Colonial Secretary, Mr. Sandys, had succeeded in agreeing on the conference minutes in a relatively uncontroversial subject, or citizenship, which was the subject of the committee's report.

The Kenyan leader, Mr. Ngũga, afterwards said that he had been surprised to find that the committee had agreed on a citizenship proposal "everything went smoothly" he said.

When Mr. L. R. M. Wood, one of the three European delegates, left Lancaster House he was clearly disappointed that the talks had ended "with nothing to say today," was his only comment.

Decision not final

It is understood, however, that his proposals for dual citizenship were rejected. His final offer has been rejected, and the subject of citizenship will come up again.

This gives the European delegates a chance, while awaiting a final decision, to prepare for a further session of three years. Instead of the two anticipated in 1961, for people who make up their minds.
