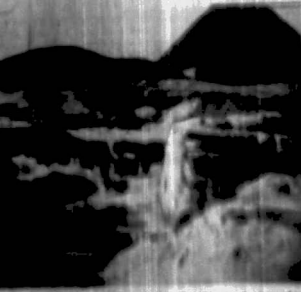

Ethiopian Manifesto

ITALIAN GOVERNMENT'S INSISTENT REFUSAL TO WAIVER

ITALY refused to terminate the Abyssinian delegation in the light of Italian demands for the withdrawal of Italian troops from the Ethiopian territory. The Italian Government refused to waive the right of Italy to be represented in the League of Nations by the Ethiopian delegate.

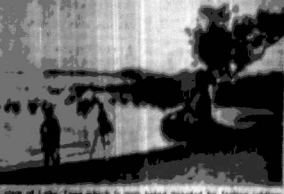

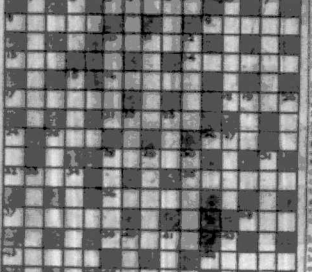

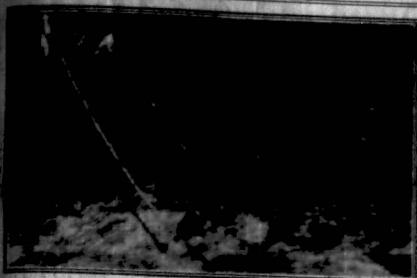

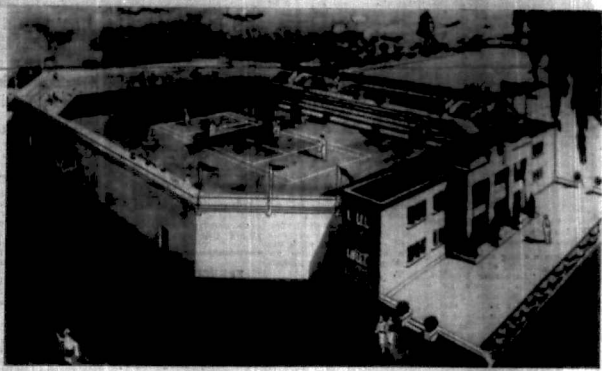

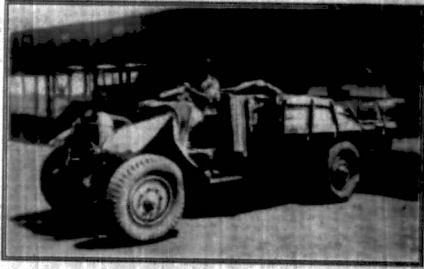

PERTINENT QUERY ON THE SANCTITY OF TREATIES

Western Air Pact

HOPE THAT PLAN MAY PROVIDE FOR LIMITATION OF STRENGTH

BRITAIN wishes to know quite definitely whether Germany now considers herself able to negotiate treaties of a binding character.

This is one of the first points made in the Questionnaire (the terms of which were included in a White Paper published yesterday).

Another query is as to whether Germany now feels she can recognize and intend to respect the existing territorial and political status in Europe, except in so far as it might be modified by free discussion and agreement.

The British Note expresses the hope that the proposed Western Air Pact would be accompanied by a scheme of limitation of air strength.

Gratification is expressed at Germany's proposals for a new system of security and her expressed desire to re-enter the League of Nations.

The Peace Proposals

Replies, May 8, which instructions were conveyed to the British Ambassador in Berlin, regarding the peace proposals being communicated on behalf of the British Government to the German Foreign Minister on the subject of the German proposals have been received by the other Powers concerned in the negotiations arising from the events of March 7, and the results of the proposals are published this morning in the form of a White Paper, containing also the two German Notes delivered in London by Herr von Ribbentrop on March 12 and April 1.
