













#### THE Kenya and Uganda Trade Report, just issued, contains an expression of opinion from the Acting Commissioner of Customs that "a measure of cautious optimism can be justified provided that the appreciable overstatement of imports is avoided."

#### The import trade increased by 15.3 per cent and the only countries that made a steady advance were Japan, United States and Germany.

#### While Uganda's proportion of the total exports declined owing mainly to a decrease in cotton and oil exports, the exports of Kenya recorded a very considerable increase.

#### Coffee, tea and sisal exports were declined, total exports by one-third and Kenya cotton by 200 per cent.

#### 15 per cent. Import Increase
