PLANT ENDS COLOUR PHOTO ENTHUSIASTS' CHIEF SNAG

A NEW plant has sprung up in Nairobi. Its aim is to supply the answers to the problem of thousands of tourists and equal numbers of Kenyans. A number of photographers who come to Kenya to see the world-famous wild life and scenery have the difficulty in obtaining the finished product of their outdoor efforts. Most photographers in Kenya are amateurs or amateurs who keep their film unexposed until they return to Europe, the United States or South Africa. So family camera work went unrecorded. Business men knew if the result was a success on a limited number of over-exposed slides.

LONG DELAY
Several photographers had to wait to develop. They had created the factory of the East African film processing plant. The first trials were likewise awaited. 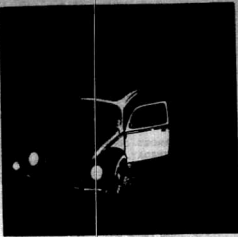

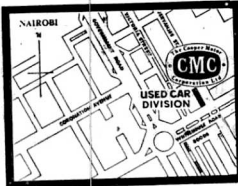

His decision, announced after a conference session climaxed a quarrel unprecedented in the history of the Commonwealth. It came after 15 hours of blunt debate spread over two days in which the absence of five leaders were strongly contended. The conference was held in London on March 13, 14 and 15. It was the last night of the Commonwealth Day in London.

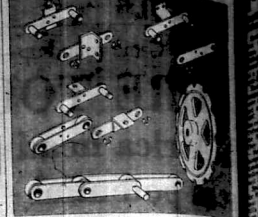

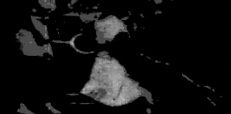
REPLAY WILL DECIDE CUP FINAL OPPONENTS

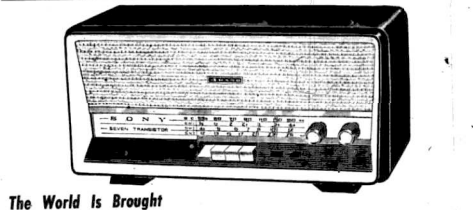

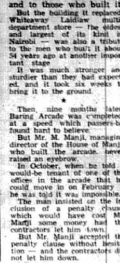
