

"Imperative Duty" Of Kenya To Provide More Flax And Cereals
CRITICAL BATTLE RAGING IN BURMA

KEVITA Legislative Council yesterday decided the Bill to provide for the increased production of crops in the Colony.

In moving the second reading of the Bill, the Financial Secretary, the Hon. L. Tesler, said its object was to enable greatly increased production of cereals and flax which it was the imperative duty of Government to do as a necessary contribution to the war effort. The present production of cereals in Kenya was such that it was well suited to supply the Middle East with Kenya. For that reason the Bill provided for increased production of wheat, maize and rice. The demand for wheat was increased through the world, for that reason and consequently the Bill made provision for increased production of that crop. Unfortunately the amount of surplus flax production was limited by the factory accommodation available.

It may well be asked with the methods for their crop control, but continued, whether the incentive of restriction alone should not be sufficient to supply the necessities required. He thought that in the event past, led to the breaking up of new acreage and an increase in the tempo of agricultural activity, on these lines alone would be sufficient to raise a contribution commensurate with the potentialities of Kenya as a primary for the entire in the Middle East.

It was in all these circumstances that the Government had decided to bring the Bill provided for the production of cereals and flax. The main outlines of the financial provisions of the Bill were:

Firstly, subject to strict conditions, a grant for bringing up to new land for cereals.

Secondly, the guaranteed minimum price for the crops concerned, and thirdly, a guaranteed minimum price for the produce of the crops concerned grown on approved acreage.

Finally, there was provision for the grant of advances up to the amount of the guaranteed minimum returns.

Guaranteed Prices And Advances To Farmers

Grants for bringing up new land to its former level have a direct relation to the production which, as far as it is concerned, can be increased. Although the main point at the moment is to increase the production of cereals and flax, it is also necessary to consider the question of the increase of the amount of land which the Government is prepared to take under the flax scheme. The fact that the Bill does not give extra land, but that a farmer chooses to work it, is a point which should be noted. 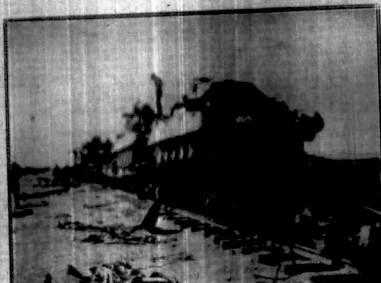
