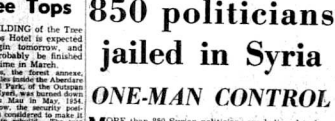

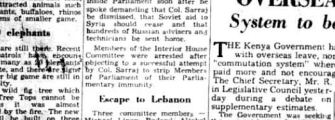

Rent Board dealt with 482 cases

Mr. Louw accuses India

THE Central Rent Control Board, Nairobi, disposed of 482 cases in 1952 according to the annual report. There were 202 cases outstanding at the beginning of 1952.

Commenting on the large number of cases, the report points out that only one case was referred to the Rent Board in 1952. It is pointed out that the Rent Board should deal with the cases in the same manner as it did in 1951. In addition, it is suggested that the Board should be empowered to deal with cases of "blatant slandering."

THREE POWERS CANNOT AFFORD SPLIT OVER EGYPT

Washington officials' view

FEELING that neither the United States nor Britain and France can afford to continue their split over Middle East politics is growing in official circles in Washington. But diplomatic observers acknowledge that official lines lie ahead before Three Power unity, confidence and co-operation is restored.

CHEUNG LOU-YU, 49, a member of the secret body known as the "One-Four-K", was being hit in the back after a "Kao" (the name of the Kowloon tenement house) was attacked and severely injured and four men armed by a "Lao Chiah" (the name of a friend) were fatally wounded in the back after a "Kao" was attacked in the "Clarle Peak" area. 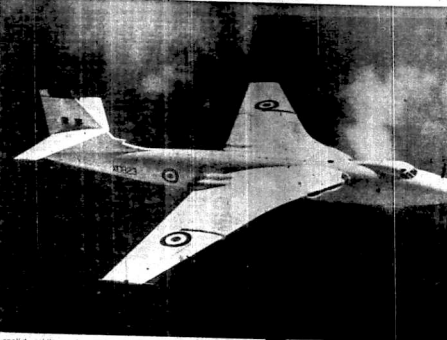

Thika college speech day

TWO main factors which were limiting faster development of money to the benefit and maintain schools were shortage of teachers, the Director of Education, Mr. W. J. Keene, said when he addressed students of Thika Training College, Thika, on a speech day on Wednesday.

"It is my hope," Mr. Keene said, "that every place in the country will have a school on its daily programme, and that the Government will be able to meet the cost of maintaining all these schools."

Mr. Keene said he was particularly interested in the development of courses for upgrading T2 teachers to T2 status.

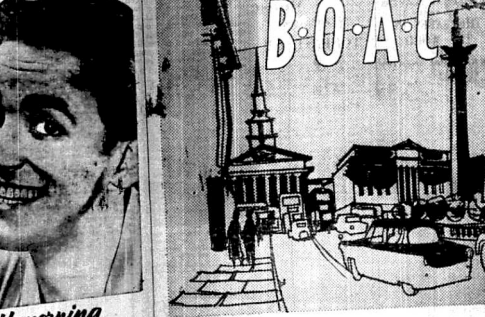

RECENTLY in the beautiful house at Kiamba which has been his home since before the First World War, Mr. P. J. H. Colman has celebrated a double anniversary—his 75th birthday and the golden anniversary of his arrival in Kenya in 1910.

Mr. Colman came out to Kenya originally to join a firm on a farm at Divoa, but when a year he set out to find a place to settle permanently. He travelled all over East Africa, including Tanganyika, then German East Africa.

Eventually, in 1910, he bought 640 acres of land at Kiamba, not so very far from the first farm on which he had worked, and settled down to develop Anner Estate.

Met in Nairobi
It was in 1910, also, that Mr. Colman married his wife, who was unfortunately crippled by arthritis, soon after Kenya as a teacher, and they met in Nairobi. They have three children, two sons and a daughter, who are all living in Kenya with their families. One son is in the Royal Navy, but is at present attached to the East African Navy in Mombasa, while the youngest son and his family live in a second house on the farm, but he has not yet managed to buy Anner.

At first the Colmans leased a house on a neighbouring farm, but within a year or two they built the house in which they still live. It is a perfectly solid, on the end of a ridge, so that the ground falls away steeply on three sides, and there is a lower ground to the plains and Divoa. The house is built on a hillside, from which we could see much of the coffee-growing land of Kenya, ridge after ridge of coffee bushes, stretching away as far as the eye could see towards Thika in one direction and Kiamba in the other.

Long ago prevailed about the house, and several hundred dead fell trees were there. There were no paths, and the only means of access to the house was by a steep slope down towards Nairobi, and a narrow track was used to bring the animals. It was on a neighbouring estate that Mr. Colman's Thomson gun found and killed six lions in his career, in a single day.

Perfectly Sited

the tea-rose house of grain, which Mr. Colman scatters on the lawn for them to share with weaver birds and doves.

Not that birds are always welcome on the farm, for the Colmans are forced to grow their peach trees inside a vast wire cage.

Very near the house stands a beautiful feature of a Kenya settler's garden, the rain garden. Nearly 50 years on the estate has shown Mr. Colman that the rainfall is steadily decreasing.

During the first ten years he was at Kiamba the average fall was 48 inches a year, but for the last ten years the average has been 30 inches. It is probably inflated, but it is a fact that a water tank is necessary the whole year round, and the water is pumped in 16 days.

With the help of the irrigation system, Mr. Colman hopes that his year Anner will equal its previous record crop of coffee—200 tons from 200 acres. That magnificent total

was reached in 1934, at a time when the price was fluctuating. It is a fact that the price was 10s a ton. Indeed, for several years during the depression, when prices were at their lowest, the crop was at its best.

During the slump, with coffee prices low, Mr. Colman has most other Kenya farmers, but he has not been able to take any of the farmers from their trunks at that time, but he has been a discoverer of gold at Kiamba. Like many others, he took an interest in the "gold rush." Once a month or so he went up to Kiamba, to prospect for gold, and he has been successful in making a few hundred pounds in the past few years.

Amner today is a highly developed and up-to-date estate, with double the 100 acres of coffee that was originally planted. The whole estate is neatly divided into sections of straight roads for traffic, and the house is a modern one with three artificial drives for coffee.

A Far Cry
This is a far cry from the early days, when the coffee was not only mechanical means of transport, but the work was done by hand, the coffee being carried in baskets, and only rarely to dry in the sun, a method which breaks more labour than can easily be obtained these days. There were no men now work on the coffee, and of them being permanently signed on, while others were during the peak season.

In past years it was not the pest of dry weather at the wrong time, or the attack of mealy bug or thrips to ruin a year's crop, but Mr. Colman pays tribute to the coffee growers who have made his benefit most of the major troubles under control.

Mr. Colman has stayed his part in the development of Kenya's coffee industry. A man of initiative and vision, he is evidence every day of the progress that has been made since he came to the Kenya Coffee Planters' Union, and was also one of those instrumental in starting the Coffee Board of Kenya. He served on the Board for many years.

Original Member
He is also a member of the Executive Committee of the Coffee Marketing Board, and a vice-chairman, and a past chairman, of the Kenya Planters' Association, of which he was one of the original members.

Mr. Colman has seen the coffee industry grow from tentative and struggling early days to the major industry it is today, and parallel with the growth of the industry has been that of his own estate. He and his wife can look back on a life which has been so well accomplished.
