## E.A. AIRWAYS TRY NEW ROUTE

### Union via Portuguese East FIRST PROVING FLIGHT TO TAKE PLACE SHORTLY

At its next Friday East African Airways will run a proving flight for its first service beyond the confines of East Africa. It will follow a coastal route linking Kenya and Tanganyika with the Portuguese East Africa and the Union. The proposed route will be along the coast via Salamis, Lindi, Moçambique, Beira, Lourenço Marques and either Durban or Johannesburg.

The information was given to a Standard reporter yesterday by Captain M. Sorbie, General Manager of East African Airways. Sorbie has just returned from a short visit to South Africa where he has been conducting negotiations about the new route.

Again Sorbie said: "The Union Government were very anxious. They will give temporary permission to operate the route and the matter will be further considered at the next meeting of the Southern Africa Air Transport Council." (This meeting is due to be held in Pretoria in February.)

**Public demand in Tanganyika**  
The General Manager added: "Negotiations still have to be completed with the Portuguese authorities, but we have permission to start a proving flight."  
The new service, when it comes into operation, will link up with the existing East African Airways Service, from Mombasa, Tanga, etc. At first it will be a one-weekly service with a second one added later. Sorbie explained that the route will be operated either by Lockheed or DC-4 aircraft. The service will meet a public demand in Tanganyika that was strongly expressed at the meeting of the association of members of the East African Airways Association in Dar es Salaam.

There has been no aerial service over the Coast since the German planes withdrew their C class flying boats. Apart from coast-wise shipping and charter aircraft, the only means of communication between Mombasa, Beira and Natal was by air.

## CHINA SAYS REDS ARE CHECKED

CHINESE Government arm-holders yesterday claimed to have crushed Communist hopes of blasting a road to the capital, Nanking, in the near future with what they termed a "massing victory on the Grand Canal front east of Hsinchou".

A Government communique claimed that eight Communist armies, totaling 160,000 men had been routed after a 39-hour battle west of Hsinchou about 124 miles north of the capital.

This ended the first phase of the war for Hsinchou, the city was captured by the Communists.

## TOJO IS ONE OF SEVEN TO HANG

Emperor should have stood trial

GENERAL Hideki Tojo, who became Japanese Premier two months before Japan attacked Pearl Harbor on December 7, 1941, was yesterday pronounced to be guilty of hanging by the International Military Tribunal in Tokyo.

Except for Manmoku Shigemitsu, a former diplomat, and Keisho Matsuda, Commander of the Central China Army, all the accused were found guilty of crimes against peace and aggressive war.

## AIRPORT BEYOND KENYA'S MEANS

### Governor gives his opinion SUBSTANTIAL OUTSIDE HELP WOULD BE ESSENTIAL

NAIROBI (The third annual dinner of the East African Association of Engineers, on Friday night, the Governor of Kenya, Sir Philip Mitchell said that while the Government were not opposed to the construction of an airport, cover with 50,000 people and in some 100,000 tons of material, it was not a desirable thing, in his judgment, the Colony to attempt to build at the cost of such an airport, even with the aid of the Royal Air Force, B.O.A.C. or the British Treasury, unless they were to bear a very large part of the cost.

This Government is firmly of the opinion that the best class modern international airport, situated at or about Nairobi as the centre of all traffic for East Africa, is a most desirable thing. But it is the most conservative estimate that it will cost two-and-a-half million pounds; my personal opinion is that including all auxiliary services, taxi cabs, etc., it will probably get any change out of three million.

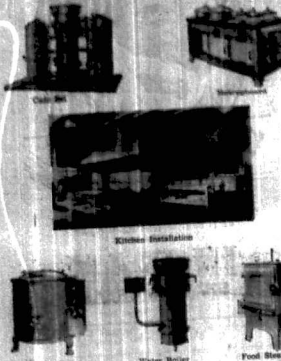

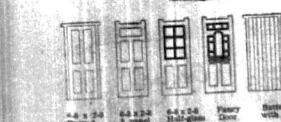

FIRST PERFORMANCE OF A LITTLE KNOWN OPERA

LONDON has had to wait 67 years for its first public performance of Verdi's Opera "Simon Boccanegra" and everyone who attended the Selsker's Wells production the other day wondered why.

As a matter of fact there are several reasons. "Boccanegra" has never been one of Verdi's most popular operas, even in Italy, partly because of its complicated plot, and partly because the score presents a curious mixture of styles. It was first produced in 1857, and since its failure, then Verdi got original ideas for the "Furber" and "Furber" to revise Verdi's original score, and for considerably improving the score. This was in 1881 after the completion of "Aida" and "Requiem". Nevertheless, it is understandable why the opera has never achieved the popularity of Verdi's other works by comparison with "Aida" and "Requiem", and even with such clear-cut ancient epic masterpieces as "Macbeth" and "Trovatore" it is laborious and inefficient in actual writing.

Norman Furber had written the libretto, which considerably simplified the elaborate story, and singing soprano as superb that even if one does not follow the plot, one is content simply to enjoy Verdi's music, sung with a quality that they matched its noble worth.

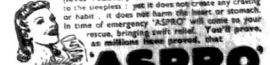
