MORE EMPHASIS WANTED ON PRODUCTIVE SERVICES

M.P. DeBate proper on Kenya's estimates of revenue and expenditure for 1964 opened in Legislative Council yesterday afternoon at the conclusion of the annual session. The members' chief complaint was the absence of the total cost of the budget.

Speakers generally confined themselves to main principles and avoided details which, in their debats on the resolution to give the estimates to the House of Representatives, have been raised on a number of occasions. Details will be discussed in the House by which the Minister of Finance, Mr. Peter Muriuki, later in the session.

First speaker in the actual debate was Mr. A. K. Njoroge, Minister of Finance and European Election Member, who commented on the "sugared pill" offered by the Member for Finance. He said that while the members of the European Community were very concerned on the matter in a rough estimate of the increased expenditure on the different types of services shown that expenditure on productive services had increased by about 15.3 per cent, on social by about 41.8 per cent and on public services, such as Police and Prisons, by about 40 per cent.

Call for more national income

"I rather feel that the time is long past when emphasis should be shifted from social to productive services. Productive services which will increase Kenya's national income. 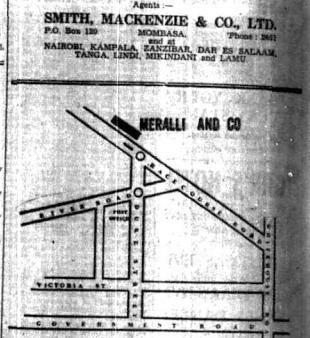



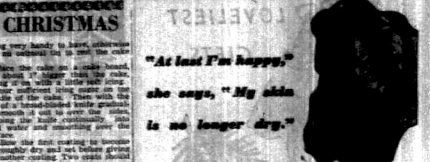

DUTCH IN ACTION IN INDONESIA

Truce with Republic ended AIRBORNE TROOPS GOING IN NEAR THE CAPITAL

Mounting uncertainty about the immediate future of relations between the Dutch and the Indonesian Republics reached a climax yesterday as dawn when the Dutch began their attack on the Republic. Following an announcement by the Dutch High Commissioner-General for the Netherlands East Indies that the Dutch had decided to end the truce with the Republic, the Dutch landed marines on the north coast of central Java and immediately claimed the capture of an airfield near Jogjakarta, the Republic's capital.

Just a week before, the Netherlands Government broke off protracted negotiations with the Indonesian Republic for the settlement of their differences.
