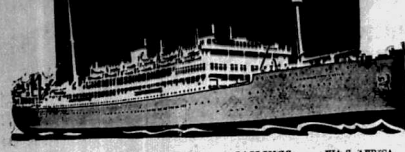

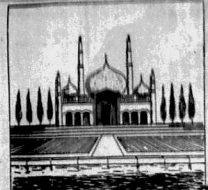

Trades Licensing Bill Improved

AS A RESULT OF WORK OF SELECT COMMITTEE

Amended Schedules

STILL REGARDED AS TOO BIG A BURDEN ON COMMERCE

Revised opposition to the Trades Licensing Bill was forthcoming from representatives of the commercial community in Legislative Council on Saturday when the measure was finally passed.

It was again contended that the new Ordinance sought to impose on business people a burden greater than they could bear and that the original intention of such legislation—which was to protect traders' had been altered in favour of strengthening the Government's financial position.

Position of Doctors and Dentists

Moving the adoption of the measure of the House Committee on the subject of the Medical Practitioners and Dentists Ordinance, Mr. Attorney-General explained the various amendments which had been made.

A further amendment proposed by the Opposition was that the Ordinance should be referred to a select committee of the Council to examine the various provisions.

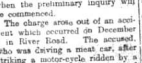

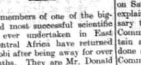

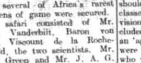

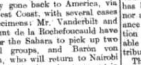

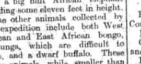

Trans-African Motor Race for £10,000

PRELIMINARY DETAILS

Conditions Which Must be Observed by Entrants

Mr. Galton-Prest writes as follows:—

I have just received it most interesting letter from Captain J. P. Duff, who is organizing the Trans-African Motor Race from Aldershot to Johannesburg in 1936. He informs me that the South African arrangements have been carried out for as possible at present and he is now on his way home to England to organize at least that end. Certain broad principles have been laid down which I think will interest members.

The idea at present is that the number of men in each car shall be limited to two and no motor permitted. If one man cannot accommodate his car he must proceed alone—wait for him. This will engender healthier competition and will prevent some wealthy entrant from securing, by sheer strength of money, an advantage in starting motor drivers all down the route to take the course from the first driver to arrive.

Qualifying Trials

There will be qualifying trials at Aldershot, each car making a run of one kilo from a standing start against an electric timing apparatus on a day or two prior to the start. At the start of the race, therefore, the fastest car will be in front and the slowest cars behind so that on the fall of the flag there will be a minimum of passing and crowding of the cars. The highway being to string out evenly from the beginning.

30 m.p.h. Town Limit

It will be a strict rule—that competitors must not exceed a speed limit of 30 m.p.h. through all towns and villages, and no competitor must pass another vehicle from behind without giving him a mile from the town there will be a notice board displaying with the above mentioned rule which will prevent dangerous driving.

The Hon. Sharnood-Don hoped that provision would be made to cover civil servants earning up to £400 per annum to contribute up to 7½ per cent. as to the rest of the small-amounted salary to be paid to the fund. It was pointed out that to realize a sufficient amount to enable him to exist on his salary or seven months without employment. For the highly-paid class he has 10 per cent. was sufficient.

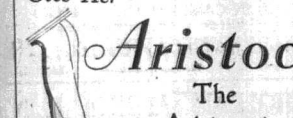

S. AFRICAN ORANGES Record Consignment to Canada

Apple accounts for the bulk of Canadian exports of fruit fresh and current shipments are of considerable quantities. This export trade is under a marketing board set up by Dominion legislation.

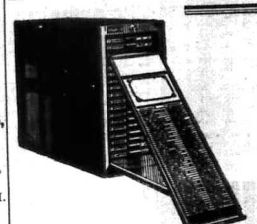
