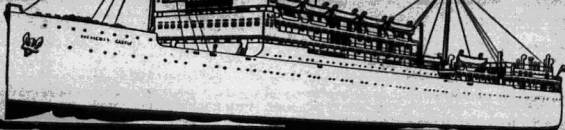

# Italy's Demand for Expansion in Africa.

## SIGNIFICANT STATEMENT BY SIGNOR MUSSOLINI.

### At Fascist Demonstration.

#### NO QUESTION OF TERRITORIAL CONQUEST INVOLVED.

The second of the five yearly celebrations of the advent of the Fascist regime in Italy, was observed in Rome on Sunday, when Signor Mussolini addressed a gathering of 7,000 leading members of the organization. During the course of his speech he reviewed Italy's foreign relations.

He stated that Italian expansion in Africa was a task for future generations of Italians. He emphasized that there was no question of territorial conquest, but added: "Let not the nations in possession block the spiritual and economic expansion of Italy."

Signor Mussolini also referred to the possibilities of collaboration with countries in Asia, pointing out that transit, whether by sea or by air, was only a matter of a few hours.

#### Dealing with the question of the League of Nations, he said that proposed reforms could wait, pending the conclusion of the Disarmament Conference. If the Conference failed there would be no need to reform the League, but simply to recede to its demise.

### The League and Disarmament.

States did not disarm they were unable logically to oppose the practical application of equality provided to Germany in 1932. He claimed that the Italian movement was the most reasonable plan to establish understanding between the small and great powers, without which Europe would sink into chaos.

Signor Mussolini stated that Italy's foreign relations were generally improving, and that Italy was ready to cooperate with the League of Nations could wait the conclusion of the Disarmament Conference, for if the Conference failed there would be no need of reform and simply to recede to its demise.

### COMMUNIST COMMITTED FOR TRIAL.

#### Mr. Tom Mann Charged with Sedition.

The London leader, Mr. Tom Mann, was charged with sedition for day-to-day comments for and against the Government on a charge of having uttered seditious remarks. He was allowed bail on a similar charge and returned on April 10 on the same bail.

Mr. Tom Mann and Mr. Henry Pritchard, the well known Communist agitator, were charged with seditious remarks at a meeting on February 28. A considerable number of other persons were charged, but had taken down in shorthand.

# Territorial Army's New Branch.

## DISCLOSED IN DEBATE ON ESTIMATES.

### "The Royal Defence Corps."

#### COMPOSED OF MEN NO LONGER FIT FOR ACTIVE SERVICE.

That a new branch of the Territorial Army is to be formed was the interesting disclosure made by the Financial Secretary of the War Office, Mr. A. Duff Cooper, during the debate on the Army Estimates.

This new branch, which will be known as "The Royal Defence Corps," will be recruited from ex-Territorial and ex-Regular soldiers. In an emergency the Corps will be used to protect strategic positions which might otherwise have to be guarded by mere able-bodied troops.

Mr. Duff Cooper in his speech warned the enthusiasts for mechanization that although the tank was a very powerful factor in modern warfare, the development of armoured steel and the development of armour-piercing projectiles were not keeping pace with each other, and the latter was likely to outstrip the former. Mr. Duff Cooper emphasized that by the infantry was the vital armament of the Country.

### Mechanized Warfare.

During his speech in the House of Commons, Mr. Duff Cooper, Financial Secretary of the War Office, introduced the House of Commons to the new branch of the Territorial Army, namely, "The Royal Defence Corps."

This would be recruited from men, primarily ex-Territorial or ex-Regulars, who were no longer fit for active service but who were in an emergency to protect vulnerable points, thus relieving fit men for active service.

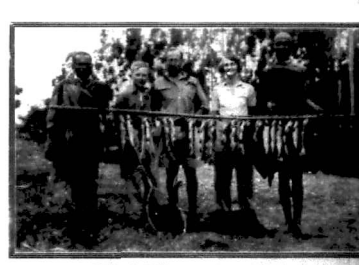

While there is general disappointment at the fact that the French reply has not indicated any leaning towards the British position, it is felt that the door has not been closed for further negotiation. The British Government will make further efforts to reconcile the French and German points of view.

#### Question of Security.

Now the Cabinet have passed further laws, one of which limits imports of raw materials to such an extent as almost to amount to a total blockade of foreign raw materials. The first materials so to be limited are cotton, wool and flax such as flax, hemp and jute.

It is proposed also that Germany and other countries should arrange to lay up a certain percentage of ship ping tonnage, and a conference of this nature is suggested. Germany proposes that the shipping companies should be paid a bonus for tonnage so laid up.

Finally the Cabinet has decreed that in the case of company dividends which exceed those paid last year, the difference must be treated in either or conventional funds and furthermore all future profits must also be so invested. The workers will benefit by another law governing unemployment contributions.

#### Compulsory Investment.

(BY WIRELESS.)

Berlin, March 23, and judgments already made as to world practically amount to a curbed out. It is intended that the decree can be nullified in the British details of import prohibition only.

#### Forced Loans.

Thirteen loans have been presented by the Cabinet, one of which is intended to raise £100,000,000 and to meet the Reichsbank to accumulate new foreign currency reserves. In fulfillment of this policy the Reichsbank is authorized to purchase abroad to importers for April only, 25 per cent of foreign exchange as against 44 per cent in March.

#### First March 24.

The first measure in the direction of limiting raw material imports was taken by the government Committee for Establishing the purchase abroad of cotton, wool and flax and substituting control orders in Berlin and Bremen to restrict the flow of imports.

In order to prevent a possibility of the temporary prohibition of the purchase abroad of cotton, wool and flax, a decree will be issued prohibiting under the same conditions any considerable increase in the price of textiles. Prohibition of foreign purchases is provided until the commission to supervise foreign imports have begun their duties.

The three commissions have now been constituted, namely, Herr Hugo Pöhl of Hesse for cotton, Herr Curtius of the Ministry of the German World Association for flax, wool and other fibres.

#### An Expensive.

It is explained that the three commissions have been established in order to examine the situation caused by the restrictions on the purchase of raw materials by the allocation of resources in Berlin. It is estimated that the total cost of the three commissions will be £100,000,000.

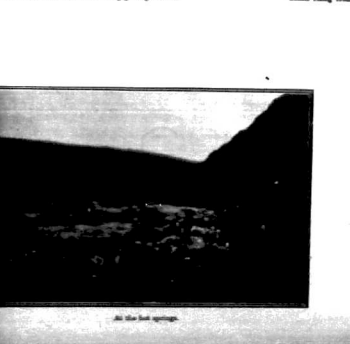
