# DR. BUNCHE ARRIVES IN KATANGA

## Earlier-than-planned visit to avert armed clash

# Premier and Ministers stay away

### DR. RALPH BUNCHE, United Nations Under-Secretary for Special Political Affairs, flew to the Katanga capital of Elisabethville yesterday — a day earlier than planned — in an attempt to avert an armed clash when U.N. troops arrive in the province tomorrow.

The Katanga Premier, M. Tshombe, and members of his Government stayed away from the airport when Dr. Bunche arrived, though there were no incidents — despite an earlier suggestion that the U.N. official's aircraft might be prevented from landing.

Observers in Leopoldville assumed Dr. Bunche wanted as much bargaining time as possible to prevent any bloodshed when U.N. soldiers begin to take over from Belgian troops in Katanga tomorrow. In view of the warning given by M. Tshombe that any U.N. entry would be opposed by force and his order for full mobilization throughout the province.

### 'Another Hungary'

Meanwhile, in Elisabethville, Katanga leaders were in touch by telephone and cable with Britain, the United States and other free countries, appealing for help in maintaining the independence of the province.

The Minister of the Interior, M. Munongo, said after a Cabinet meeting that Katanga was becoming "another Hungary". There were thousands of men under arms, he claimed, and trial courts were meeting in hotels and pavement cafes to discuss what support the U.N. official's aircraft might be prevented from landing.

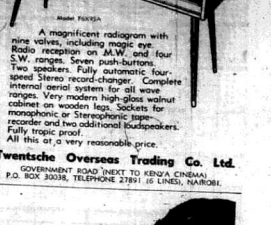

# WEEK-END STANDARD ROPE RAILWAY OVERCAME PROBLEMS SET BY RIFT VALLEY

At the end of the 19th century, the men building the railway from the coast to Lake Victoria were faced with the formidable problem of negotiating the sheer drop into the Rift Valley. Their ingenious solution was to continue the permanent way along the foot of the Kikuyu Escarpment and at the same time to construct a temporary rope railway so that wagons loaded with material could be lowered down the very steep slope.

The East African Railways and Harbours are at present producing a film, "Permanent Way," and two members of the railway architect's department were responsible for making a model of the old rope rail.

An East African Standard photographer went to see the film "Permanent Way" and brought back a number of the old rope rail, and a picture, together with a letter from the architect of the East African Railways building department.

In his book, "Permanent Way" (E.A.R. and H. 22/3), Mr. M. L. Hill writes that the railway builders decided to push on quickly with operations on the Rift Valley by ascending the escarpment by means of a rope incline and to lay a temporary line along the foot of the Kikuyu Valley to the plain between Longmont and Kisumu.

Mr. Hill continues: "The final report of the Uganda Railway Committee, dated 1871, was reached and even then a few miles beyond the limit of the Kikuyu range long before the permanent way on the descent into the Rift Valley could be ready, and therefore, some temporary arrangements could be made for the construction in the valley and beyond, a road by sections, stepping and delayed."

### FOUR PARTS

"The nature of the ground rendered temporary structures able on the score of expense, and it was decided therefore, to construct an inclined lift on very steep slope on the descent into the Rift Valley, and to lay a road from the foot of the cliff to the point where the sections stepped down from the rocky slopes of Kikuyu."



### As it was — and now

### CLIP DRUMS

"The two middle portions are an inch or nearly so apart and are supported by steel clips, 10 inches in diameter, six inches in thickness, all attached to winding engine. On these inclines the wagons are taken on a carrier built with its horizontal bar and a pair of rails to take the wheels and suitable clips and to allow the wheels to slip on the rails while the carrier is being lowered. The carrier is 5 feet 6 inches in order that it may be lowered laterally."

"At the top the carrier comes up against a platform (ten-inch wide) in front of the clip drums. From a continuation of a road ending on the station of the road, allowing a wagon to be pushed on to the carrier by hand. At the bottom the carrier goes into a pit, with the rails similarly coincide with a road. (Cont. in Page 11, Col. 2.)"

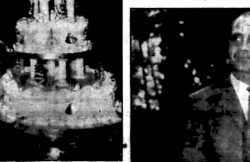

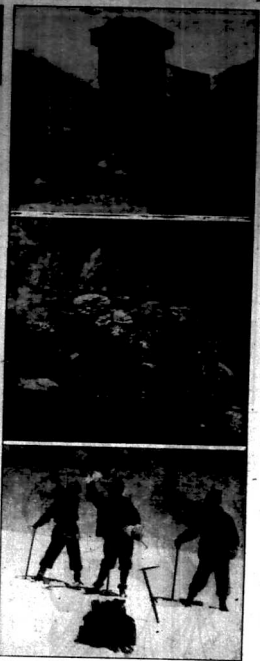

Later he served in India and Mesopotamia. After the war he served with the King's African Rifles in Uganda. He retired from the Army in 1925. In the following years he transferred to the museum. Most of the collections were transferred from his father's home in England to Kenya where they were housed in a mud and wattle thatched building, temporarily.

**ANNUAL** Government grants for the Stoneham Museum amount to a mere £100 compared with the £1,000 a year received by the Coryndon Museum. Membership costs only 10/- a year and the Director hopes that as many visitors as possible will become members. The museum is open all day during the week and on Sunday afternoon. Price of admission is only 1/- for Africans and Europeans and 50 cents for Africans. Children are admitted at half-price.

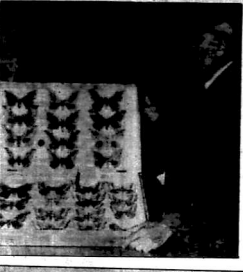

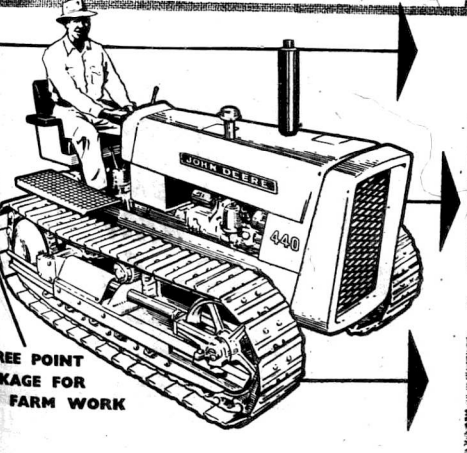
Left, the director, Col. Stoneham, displays a case of giant moths whose size can be appreciated when compared with the tin cent piece in the top of the case.

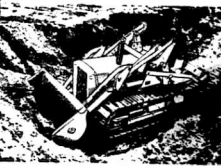

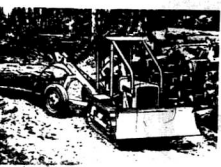
