Refresher training for the Kenya Police

TWO WEEK COURSES AT NAKURU CENTRE

The old police inspectors' course at Nakuru, held during the Emergency as the temporary base for the regular and reserve police officers, has been made as a permanent training centre for police in the Rift Valley Provinces.

The main centre of police instruction in Kenya is the Police Training School, Kisumu. There, 1,000 joined recruits undergo their initial training and are sent to the Force up to and including chief inspectors' rank. In the course of refresher courses, however, provide refresher courses for candidates, or for N.C.O.s every five years, or for every three years.

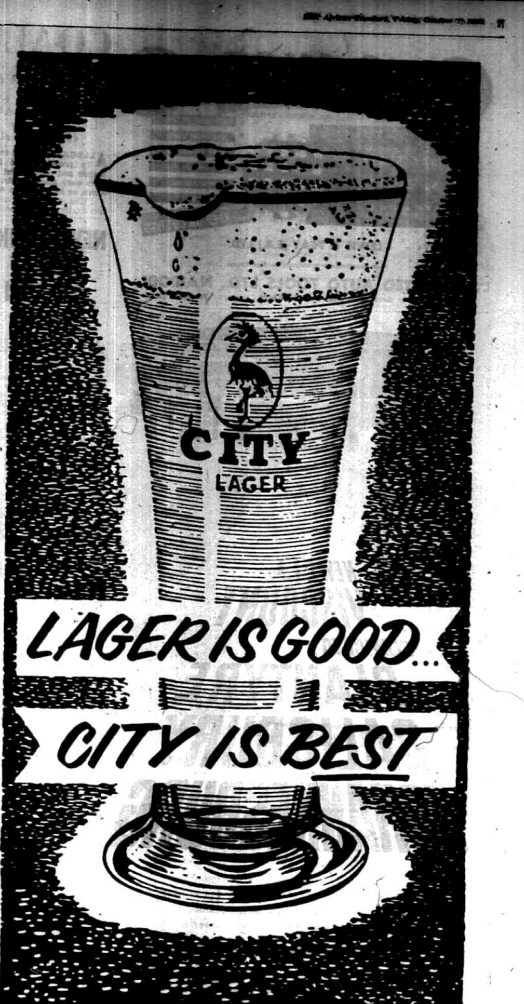

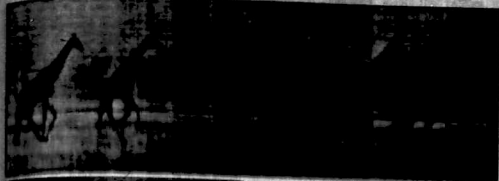

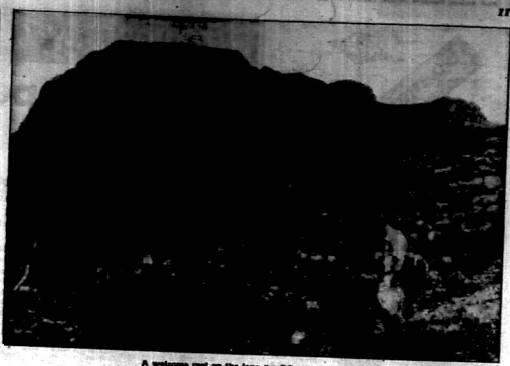

'WALK' FOR THE MORE ENERGETIC

MOUNT ELGON, at 14,781ft., the second highest mountain in Kenya, makes an excellent subject for photography and also provides a good day's exercise. The mountain, called Masarwa by the African, is 40 miles in diameter at the base.

Said to be the largest single volcanic mass in the world, Mount Elgon was formed at the same time as Mounts Kenya and Kilimanjaro and the Rift Valley were formed. In a car it is possible to drive 10,000ft. up the 11,000ft. in a four-wheel drive vehicle.

PETER HEATHCOTE, a Standard Staff photographer, wrote this article on Mount Elgon as well as taking the photographs.

With a party of four, including Kenneth Mason, the Nairobi actor, we drove to the lower height from Kitale.

Then we began the walk. It is, in fact, a walk and not a climb as that implies no climbing experience are necessary. If it is advisable, however, to

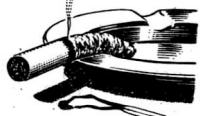
