UCANDA FIGHTS RABIES MENACE

DURING the next two years, the newly set up United Nations Technical Assistance Board in Dar es Salaam will be providing \$2,000,000 programme for ridding Tanganyika of 48 species of insects which threaten its agriculture, industry, and tourism.

The office, which runs U.N. aid programmes in Kenya, Uganda and Zanzibar, will be providing health programme technical assistance in Tanganyika and Zanzibar through the United Nations Technical Assistance Board in Dar es Salaam.
