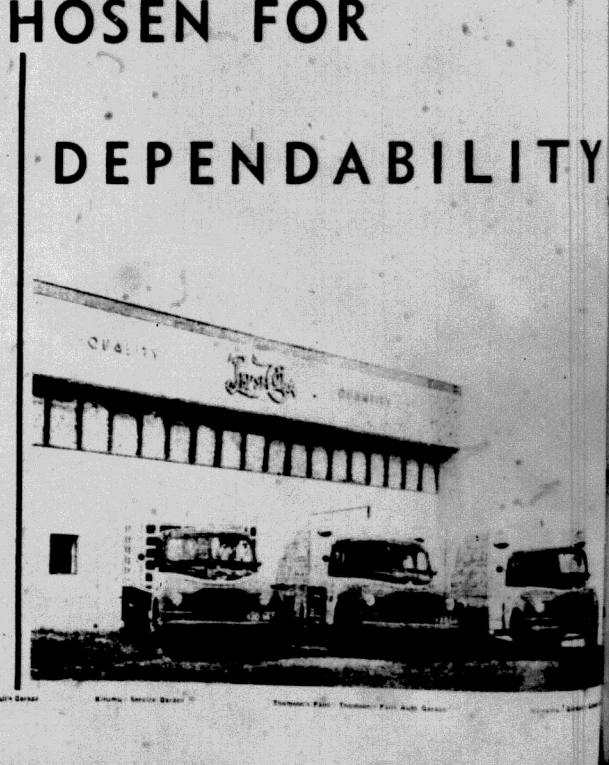

 STEEL production in Britain has more than doubled during the period 1926 to 1946 according to a United Nations survey of world economic and social development just published. Production figures in Britain which were 1,443,000 metric tons in 1926 had risen to 3,823,000 in 1946.
 This compares with an increase of 100 per cent in the United States of America. The total world output of steel in 1946 was 100,000,000 metric tons, of which Britain's share was 3.8 per cent.
 The report states that the steel industry in Britain has made a remarkable recovery since the war. It notes that the industry has not only replaced the steel lost during the war but has also increased its production capacity. The report also mentions that the steel industry in Britain has been one of the most successful in the world in terms of productivity and efficiency.

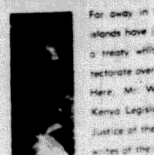

INDIA'S FOREIGN EXCHANGE CONTROL EXTENDED TO PAKISTAN, AFGHANISTAN

The Reserve Bank of India has announced the extension of its exchange control to Pakistan. As from last Tuesday the exchange control to be created as a foreign currency for all purposes of financial transactions and would be subject to regulations imposed under foreign exchange regulations, the Bank stated.

Merchandise from India to Pakistan can now be made only through authorized dealers in foreign exchange.

Exchange control has also been extended to Afghanistan.

ENGLAND WIN THE FINAL TEST MATCH

Australia's first defeat since 1938

AUSTRALIA were beaten in a Test match for the first time in 15 years yesterday when England won the fifth and final match of the present series at Adelaide by eight wickets. England's last victory over Australia was at the Kensington Oval in 1938.
