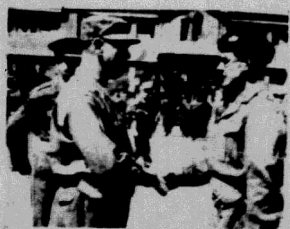

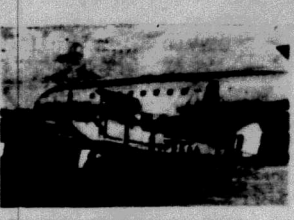

NEW RAILWAY SURVEY ON WAY

Announcement from London TO DETERMINE BEST ROUTE FOR RHODESIA-EAST AFRICA LINK

NEW survey to determine the best route for a railway link between Rhodesia and East African ports to be held in London, it was announced in London by the Economic Cooperation Administration (Marshall Plan) mission to the United Kingdom. The survey is a joint project of the Economic Cooperation Administration and the British Colonial Office and is part of the Joint Transport Plan for African transport which was drawn up in October.

The announcement, declared in the survey, is to be completed by a British firm of consulting engineers in cooperation with the Government of Rhodesia and the Government of Kenya. The survey team will be headed by Mr. J. G. Taylor, Chief Engineer of the Rhodesia Railways, and Mr. J. G. Taylor, Chief Engineer of the Kenya Railways.

The survey will be completed by the end of 1954 and will be followed by a detailed design and construction programme for the link. The link will be a single-track railway, 2 ft 6 in. gauge, and will be built to a standard of 100 miles per hour.

DEFENCE CONFERENCE IN LONDON

Middle East chief topic for discussion

The defence conference to be held in London for some Commonwealth countries on June 21 will be concerned chiefly with the contributions which South Africa and other interested countries are to make in manpower and equipment for the defence of the Middle East, it was generally believed by observers.

The conference, which will also be attended by representatives of the United States, will be held at the Royal College of Defence Studies in London. It is expected that the conference will discuss the need for a common defence policy in the Middle East and the role of the Commonwealth countries in this regard.
