



# THE IMPORTANCE OF THE VOLLEY

Essential part of modern forcing game

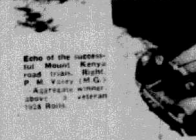
