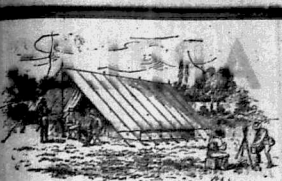

[STANDARD] COMMISSIONER London.
Professor Arthur Lloyd James, long known as the leading adviser to the B.B.C. and Secretary of the B.B.C. Advisory Board, has been charged with the murder of his wife, Bronwen, in a world broadcast under the name of Elia Crane. The professor, a world authority on phonetics, fled his radio station some years ago with his talks on dialect, which he continued with the greatest ease for purposes of illustration.
Divisional Detective-Inspector Orland alleged that when he was arrested by the police, he said: "I thought my powers were failing and I could not come with my wife. Rather than expect her to face a trial, I decided she should die and did not intend to face it."
Another statement alleged by the inspector to have been made by the professor was: "We were so happy I wanted her to die while she was like that; her eyes were shining home with a nervous breakdown. We expect to be happy."
When asked by the Clerk of the Court whether he had questions to put to the Inspector, Professor James said: "I did not think I said the words that you mention that I would take my own life."
Inspector Orland said that he saw the body of Mrs. James in the drawing-room at their home in Holloway Avenue, Hampstead, and Professor James was in the dining-room. He had two scratches on his left cheek, and that there were bloodstains on the cuffs of his shirt and also a large stain on the collar and a pocket at the police station. He saw traces of blood on Professor James's fingernails and around the cuticles. When asked to make a written statement, after being charged, Professor James said, "My brain was not functioning." Consequently no statement was given. Accused was remanded.

Prison Sequel To Joy Ride

Having pleaded guilty to unlawful removal of a car, three South African soldiers sentenced to a month's hard labour in the Resident Magistrate's Court at Nairobi yesterday.
Chief Inspector Scott informed his court that in this particular case the car, taken from Harding Street, Nairobi, was recovered 30 miles beyond Macheloak, having been driven there 18 miles. In fairness to the accused it should be stated that some of the men have been taken on the journey, because the car was undamaged despite the condition of the road.
Emphasis of the seriousness of the type of crime, Mr. Scott added: "Since the beginning of the year 1943, there have been 200 such cases. In these cases I have been instructed to ask for severe sentences, as they are far too common."

Work By Prisoners Of War A COMPLICATED QUESTION

It has been recommended or suggested in certain quarters recently that steps should be taken to utilize prisoners of war taken in East Africa as labour on works of national importance, such as road-making, soil conservation, and malaria schemes, etc.
The East African Standard learns that Government has been by no means idle in this respect and that careful consideration has been given to the possibility, especially during the last six weeks. It will be realized, however, that this is a complicated question, with all sorts of difficulties to be overcome before any particular scheme can get into working order.
Not the least important considerations especially in regard to road-making on a big scale, are the necessary facilities for the supply of materials both of which may require decisions in London as well as locally. Nevertheless, it is hoped that arrangements will be made to engage prisoners of war on useful work in the Colonies under other or better than unreasonable terms.

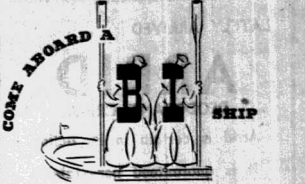
Coffee Producers' Worries

Parlous Position Of The Bigger Growers

["STANDARD" CORRESPONDENT] London. 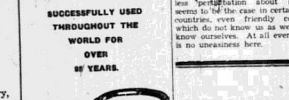

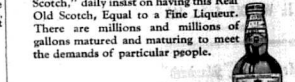

News From Nyasaland

The latest news supplied by the Nyasaland Information Officer, from Zomba, is given below—

The various plantations of the Nyasaland Defence Force have now "passed of the square" and a high degree of efficiency has been attained. Instructions in the use of light automobiles has now commenced.

The Royal-royal Governor, Sir Donald Mackenzie-Kennedy, K.C.M.G., recently inspected the Zomba platoon. After the inspection he spoke some words of encouragement, and congratulated the men on the enthusiasm shown and the degree of efficiency already attained. He announced that hereafter the Defence Force would be under the command of the senior military officer in Nyasaland and has not any more undertaken locally by the K.A.R. an opportunity would be afforded for the Nyasaland Defence Force to take part in WAR EFFORT.

SUMMER FLOWER SHOW

An event of note has been the combined Summer Flower Show of the Royal Horticultural Gardens Club, which was held at Limbe on 11th February. The display of flowers was better than is usual at this time of the year owing to the absence of excessive rain.

There has been considerable progress in most areas during the current crop season. In the Lower River areas the food position is still below average, but is not serious. In most other parts of the Southern Province the situation is satisfactory. In the Northern Province also with improvement in the rains the crop prospects are good.

In North Nyasa the recently matured cotton crop reported to be a rotten prospect as a whole. The situation in the Southern Province is also satisfactory.

The tobacco season is later than usual but of the conditions one can say that it is favourable it is likely that there will be a record crop of fire-cured. In regard to numerous crops of a decreasing nature in planting in the evening field it is estimated that the crop will be as great as that of last year, owing to the high yields resulting from the early crop coming in from the hills, and the crop of 2nd and 3rd cuts.

The Council of Livestock Control, eleven in all, recently visited the military camp at Mbagha, Malindi. They were shown all over the camp and were immensely impressed with all they saw. In particular they were struck by the remarkable improvement in appearance of their people. These latter were better than anything the Council had seen elsewhere. This was due to the adequate and balanced diet apart from their military importance afforded to them, which should prove valuable after the war.

engaged," he wrote yesterday, "the Government and people are more than willing to buy foodstuffs so that food may go into France if it were possible. The Government would reach the French and not the Germans. At present, he said, a large percentage of the food which reaches France, whether from abroad or from our own colonies, goes to Germany and Italy."

"If the United States were prepared to supply the French for sea food that American food actually reached the French Government would not be the slightest objection."

"We may assume, though the correspondent does not say so that if the United States did not undertake such a task it is because it is hardly possible, even if food went only to the French, the Germans would directly benefit by withholding stocks they have already secured and stored."

The Vichy Government, in its present attitude against the British, has not been averse to the proposal, as phrased by the Chicago Daily News, that Germany supervise all the imports of food and the French in some degree be allowed to keep only 20 per cent. of these imports.

A later factor which does not seem to be a strong criticism from the United States is that French food ships would be conveyed by French vessels through the British blockade.

The New York Daily Mirror says that the American Embassy in London is aware of the responsibility of starvation and adds that Admiral Darlan's threat is an attempt to drive a wedge between Britain and the United States.

A United States commentator remarks that Admiral Darlan says the blockade is severe but that France is concerned, and adds it must be hard for the man who, getting the British blockade in 1939 to say that, if the French are to get their food it is not the British blockade but German greed, which is the reason.
