REPORTS from Geneva and Moscow yesterday indicated that the end of the seven-week Indo-China war was at hand. The Russians disclosed an agreement on the major questions had been reached.

Ministers in Geneva were busy all day at a series of decisive meetings aimed at sweeping away the last few obstacles to a cease-fire by Mr. Eden and Mr. Molotov met in the morning after the British Foreign secretary had seen the French and Soviet leaders separately. Mr. Chou En-lai had lunch with Mr. de Mendès-France. The final session of the conference was, due to begin in the Palace of Nations at any time after 6 p.m.

India is likely to accept the invitation to serve on an Indo-Chinese armistice commission. It was learned in New Delhi. Canada and Poland also have been asked to serve.

# ON THE HUNT—WITH A FILM CAMERA

Lesley Clay introduces you to a man and wife team who are always on the hunt—with a film camera. In their visits to many parts of Africa they have created films of wild life and the indigenous peoples, which have been acclaimed on both sides of the Atlantic.

WHEN I first met Michaela Denis she was acting as double for Deborah Kerr who came to Africa to make a film of King Solomon's Mines for Metro-Goldwyn Mayer.

This modest role gave a little hint of Michaela's talents or, indeed, of her wild personality until one day, when she went to Michaela to watch the film-making.

A big crowd of Wakamba had been assembled in an open space where the camera were waiting when suddenly, to my astonishment, Michaela slipped in among the Africans and escorted them to dance. In a few moments she was the centre of a whirling, milling crowd of spears, loincloths, and heaving, clattering, drumming, and shouting, but Michaela's family held the role of premiere dancer.

They returned to Nairobi for a period to supervise the completion of the house they and her husband, Armand Denis, world traveller and master of films of wild life that she was London-born, and a Soviet Russian descent, and I, her father was a writer and archaeologist. Michaela began her career as a fashion designer, but is increasingly knowledgeable about anthropology, zoology and archaeology. One of her most fascinating pieces of knowledge is the knowledge of the aboriginal human heads, most of which come from the Ecuadorian head hunters. But aside from that, no more truly feminine personality could be found.

With her bright green hair, her glittering jewels, and her silver finger-rings, she is a head turner. There they found the inhabitants dressed in tinted-papaya feathers, wearing fantastic head-dresses and carrying spears. 
