FRANCE'S POSITION in the European Economic Community is being tested in Brussels yesterday when the French Prime Minister, Mr. Guy Mollet, was faced with what is probably the most difficult of his whirlwind career.

Mr. Mollet, speaking for Italy, West Germany and Luxembourg as well as his own country, was being plain-spoken in attacking the Dutch Foreign Minister, Mr. J. W. Beyers, and the Belgian Foreign Minister, Mr. Paul-Henri Spaak, who are both members of the E.C.C. partners. A hint of the sharp rebuff which was given in an hour's talk with the Belgian Foreign Minister, Mr. Spaak, was given in an hour's talk with the Luxembourg Foreign Minister, Mr. J. W. Beyers.

## India agrees to New Delhi meeting with Portuguese

The reports say that there was no contact between the Portuguese Government and the National Volunteers alleged that Portuguese troops were fired on by Indian volunteers when they reoccupied the fort.

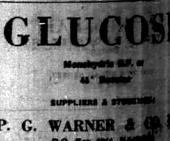

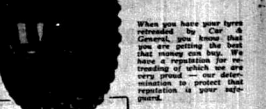

Kikuyu combat unit harries terrorists

60 MAU MAU CAMPS FOUND

FOR a year a group of Kikuyu Guard who have been patrolling the Aberdare Forest above the Ohya Division in the Forest District, have become one of the most experienced of forest patrol-ers who have ferretted out 60 terrorists' camps and killed 49 gangsters. In June last year, an officer of the Kenya Regiment was on patrol with a section of Kikuyu Guard in the forest. The operation was successful and he was impressed with their skill at finding their way about the difficult forest terrain, that he was convinced a permanent striking force of the Kikuyu Guard would be invaluable in the forest. The officer, Hugh Davies, who spent many years in the Indian Army, later in the month took a group of thirty-five Kikuyu Guard posts of Chinjo-foa-foa, near Mt. Kenia, to Kikuyu Maize.

After a month's preliminary training in military drill, the unit was sent to Kikuyu. The company of the Kenyan Regiment who were patrolling the Forest River valley in search of Mau Mau hide-outs, were based in the Kikuyu Camp quarters. But their first success was obtained in the month of June when they captured the Mau Mau camp in the Chinjo River, three miles from the Kikuyu Maize. The Mau Mau, when they shot a terrorist known to have committed three murders.

Modern weapons Later they moved north again to the Forest River. In the month of July, they were armed with the latest equipment and were sent to Kikuyu. The unit is armed with rifles, a machine gun and a light machine gun. Each man is equipped with a sword, a bayonet, a tommy gun, a gas mask, and a gas mask canister. The unit is divided into four parties, each of which is trained in first-aid and first-aid training. Sometimes, reinforced by other Kikuyu Guard units, they have made 19 patrols so far.

# THE HOUSE ON CRATER LAKE

**AFTERNOON** tea is an institution where British people meet. Indeed, the habit now obtains almost everywhere in the world.

One would naturally expect it to prevail in East Africa but I was not prepared for the sort of tea-party my Lady Oulton and Mrs. Gladys Rydon's house overlooks in Tanganyika.

I should think that all the oldest residents of the three Territories have heard of the house on the crater during the war. With two friends I drove up the steep drive and arrived at the front of the house where Jasmine Mounting and I sat in a riot of assorted cushions. At the view which we had driven nearly two hundred miles to behold. It was even more beautiful than I had expected. It was even more beautiful than I had only to a far bank, flanked on the left by Mount Meru and, when the weather is kind, dominated by a glorious view of the snow-capped flattened peak of Kilimanjaro.

## Fed By Warm Springs

The lake is tree-enclosed and green, grassy banks lead down to its shores. Several hundred steps wender down from the crater-crest terrace to an improvised puntoon bridge from which Mrs. Rydon takes her daily swim with her for a short distance and found the water a comfortable temperature, for it is fed by warm springs. Back again on the terrace, other guests began to arrive in a steady stream until 30 were drinking cups of tea and eating the home-made scones for which Mrs. Rydon is also famous.

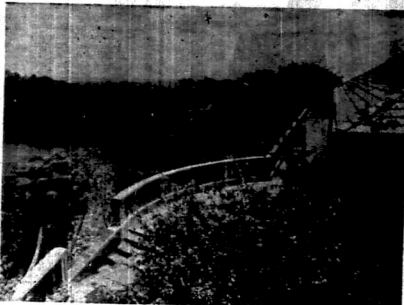
I was introduced to a Polish Count and Countess, a German irrigation expert, an American tourist, two Irish through a telescope for the first sight of Kilimanjaro punctually at 6.30 p.m.

I made a brief tour of the house with my hostess. Some of the bigger and loveliest sweet peas I have ever seen were massed in bowls round the room which was set off by gold curtains and gay chintzes.

A huge chest, looking as if it came straight from the Orient, turned out to be an ordinary seaman's chest superimposed with brass.

Two paintings in the dining-room caught my eye; one of Kilimanjaro, the painting by Mrs. Rydon's doctor son, Arthur; the other, of Mount Meru, by her second son, David, who is a talented musician. A little group is a good collection of butterflies.

The house is built on two levels, with the kitchen, pantry and office on the lower floor, and, in discharging it herself, Mrs. Rydon made it as

much as possible like her Australian home in Brisbane. (She has lived in Kenya, however, since 1920.)

Out of her bedroom—which is notable for its sunken bath—the looks on to a luminous display of purple and terra cotta bougainvilleas.

I had just time for a quick round the extensive grounds before we all assembled on the terrace for a last look

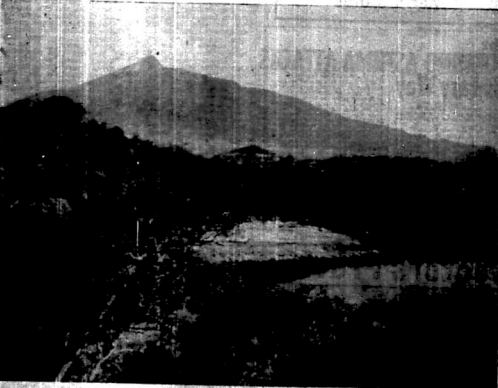
at Kilimanjaro. Two very special things about the garden, which is constantly being added to and improved upon, are the pure white bougainvilleas, a present from Lady Irving, and the wild white delphiniums, the only scented kind in the world, self-sown in her garden.

Mrs. Rydon also owns two coffee plantations and some pyrethrum on the mountain.

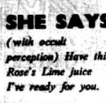

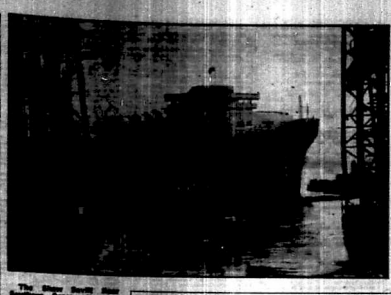

### July exports best for 30 months

BRITAIN'S July exports were the best for two-and-a-half years, including £3,200,000,000, the highest total since 1927, which is 20 per cent above the second quarter of the year, 1952. They were five per cent more than in July of last year.

Point of trade was the main factor in the increase, with a relaxation of import restrictions in many important countries in 1954.

In North America in July, exports were £710,000,000, the second highest in the series for the last 20 years.

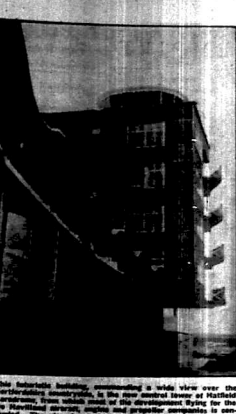

At present, one acre of the Highlands produces only one ton of maize, whereas in the European community region that the same acre would produce 10 tons of maize. The problem is to find the means of increasing the output of the Highlands by their intensive use."
