KENYA RADIO: BIG CHANGES PROPOSED

Advanced programmes for three races

The Kenyan Broadcasting Corporation, which the Government would like to provide about £440,000, spread over a period of five years, is advocated in the report of the Kenya Broadcasting Commission, issued today.

The recommendations that the new corporation should be set up as soon as possible after the expiry of the present licence held by Cable and Wireless, are as follows:

The corporation would be given sufficient strength to ensure publicity from all quarters. These services should be supplemented by broadcasts in vernacular languages for the Kikuyu, Luo, and Kamba and Mombasa. The corporation should be given the right to accept advertising on a limited basis should it be necessary to cover the cost of broadcasting.

The programme should consist of entertainment and information, and should be planned to the provision of a wide and active service of news, current affairs, and educational programmes. The programme should be developed in local languages and in English. WEST GERMAN MINISTER DEMANDS SOVEREIGNTY

SIR WINSTON CHURCHILL reviewed British policy in the light of the collapse of the European Army project, at a specially called Cabinet meeting yesterday afternoon.

Earlier, the Premier had consultations with Mr. Eden, British Foreign Secretary, Lord Laming, Secretary-General of the North Atlantic Treaty Organisation, and Sir Gladwyn Jebb, British Ambassador in France, who he took to Paris late last night.

In the first formal comment on the French Assembly's rejection of E.D.C., a Foreign Office spokesman said, "It is deeply regretted that the French did not ratify the treaty. A major British aim now was to save from the wreckage of Western policy the good will and co-operation of Federal Germany. Primary responsibility for planning an alternative form of West German rearmament rested with the three occupying Powers—Britain, the United States and France.

M. Mendes-France the French Premier, is expected to fly to London shortly to resume negotiations with the British Government. He told the National Assembly he had been assured that the "work of exploration" could start soon. "No move would be made to implement the Bonn agreements, however, until the Assembly had been consulted."

PASSBOOK CONTROL OFFICE—DILMARE AVENUE, PUNJAWA HALLS—(MONDAY ONLY)

After September 15th no further applications will be accepted. All applications should be made in person at the KIKUYU, EMBU and MERU offices in Nairobi, or at the offices of the Nairobi Municipal Council in Nairobi. If it is desired to visit the office to be provided with a Passbook, it is necessary to be accompanied by a male dependant of the person to whom the Passbook is to be issued. If you wish the dependants of their KIKUYU, EMBU and MERU servants to be provided with Passbooks, they should make application immediately to the control residential areas staff, who will refer the application and their recommendation to the Municipal Council.

It is emphasized that a Passbook is primarily an identity document and that possession of a Passbook does not itself authorize the holder either to be in Nairobi or to leave or enter the City. If the holder of a Passbook, whether Male or Female, wishes to be in Nairobi without a Passbook or to leave the City, his attention is drawn to the fact that a Passbook is not a passport and that a Passbook is not a passport. SIR MOYMER WHEELER, the British archaeologist at Oxford yesterday blamed East Africa's Public Works Department and those 'verily for their lack of care' for increasing the rate of destruction since the war of archaeological evidence and artistic material in East Africa.
