DECONTROL OF MEAT AND VEGETABLES

Increase in prices not expected

HOUSEWIVES ASSURED OF GOOD SUPPLIES

The decontrol of meat and vegetables in Kenya, announced this morning, gives the City's housewives a chance to lower their bills—if they are prepared to buy selectively.

Traders are emphatic that prices will not rise; except them to fall slightly. The president of Nairobi Greengrocers Association, Mr. M. Z. Malik, said: "Spices are good and when the farmers know their prices are no longer controlled it is likely they will bring in more produce. Prices cannot go up."

The city's butchers are no longer effectively organised, but a leading member of the trade stated: "If anything, our effort to let prices rise—our wholesale ones are still fixed by the Meat Commission and prices are, if anything, too high now."

Price controls have been lifted also on fish; imported trout; rock salt; fishing nets; hard-currency motor vehicles; hand fibre products from the United States, Ltd.; reinforcing fabrics and expanded metal; hard-currency agricultural plant and implements; weighing machines; hand bars; steel plates; different types of wire; and hair-dressing for male Africans.

Five items are still controlled. They are: cement, charcoal, wood fuel, wheat flour, maize, coffee, rice and sugar. It is hoped to free wheat by the end of the year when the Mombasa Harbour facility increased supplies. Charcoal and wood fuel remain controlled. A large shortage of cement has occurred in the main trading period.


The future of wheat flour, maize and rice, the major staples, would continue to be controlled. Cereals which are imported at the same time, the Kenya Government is taking steps to ensure their local production.

FIRM PLANS ATTRACTIVE HOMES FOR EMPLOYEES

THE intention of the East African Portland Cement Co., Ltd. when they erect their new cement works at Athi River, is to provide attractive modern housing for their African employees. Mr. H. G. Vernon, chairman of the board, told the East African Standard that it had always been the company's intention to expand and erect a complete cement works when conditions in the country warranted it. At their present works in Nakuru, they employ 200 African and 100 European staff.

Mass safeguarded
Behind this announcement was a great deal of investigation in the field covering many years. "Our investigation went to find raw materials in the right location," Mr. Vernon explained. Athi River was conveniently placed in relation to the main railway line and it was served by a good road connection to existing centres. One of the main economic objections that had been acquired in the area, in connection with other raw materials, would enable them to manufacture Portland Cement of the highest quality.

Share capital
It is estimated that the Athi River cement works will have an output of 100,000 tons a year and will in this production be worth the sum of £1,000,000. The company has also granted a 500-acre lease of 100 acres to the British Virginian Co. on terms which safeguard fully the rights and interests of the local Maasi in matters of fertility, traffic and water.

The present share capital is being raised to £2,000,000. Mr. Vernon said it was too early yet to comment on any plan for training Africans for employment in the new works.

Russia could cover Western Europe with atomic rockets

RUSSIA has rockets which could strike against the West with enough accuracy to make the tactical use of atomic warheads entirely practicable, according to the views of a British aircraft design engineer in a book published yesterday. The book, by Mr. Kenneth W. Gifford, contains a mass of information which has leaked out concerning Russian progress in rocket weapons. His verdict is: "Although it would be unwise to place complete reliance on all the information that has been made public of Russia's growing capacity in long-range weapons, some of the various reports that have come to hand over the past few years appear to reveal an underlying current of truth."

SOUTH-EAST ASIAN DEFENCE PACT SIGNED

Signatories to issue 'Pacific Charter'

JOINT ACTION AGREED ON COMMON DANGERS

EIGHT nations signed the South-East Asian Treaty at Manila yesterday, promising to stand together against aggression in South-East Asia and the South-West Pacific. They agreed at the same time to issue a declaration of principles to be known as the "Pacific Charter".

The treaty, signed by Thailand, Laos, Cambodia, Vietnam, Burma, the Philippines, Malaysia and Singapore, is a landmark in the history of the region. It is the first time that the nations of South-East Asia and the South-West Pacific have agreed to stand together against aggression in their own region.

The treaty also provides for the signing of a separate protocol covering a separate region including the general area of South-East Asia and South-West Pacific but also including the whole territory of any of the "Pacific Charter" signatories that may be attacked by any of the "Pacific Charter" signatories. This means that an attack on any "East West Pacific" area by any of the "Pacific Charter" signatories will be covered by the treaty.

Soldiers to act as holiday guards for farms

FOOD, BONUS SCHEME

The Board of Agriculture has announced details of a new scheme designed to assist farmers who wish to take local leave without leaving their farms unattended. The Board has made arrangements with the military authorities for farmers requiring assistance of this nature to be put in touch with British officers or other ranks who volunteer to act as caretakers while the farmers are away on leave.

These caretakers will be granted leave for periods of up to six months, and will normally act in pairs.

Apply to Army

Although the soldiers will not be allowed more than 14 days leave at a time, farmers wishing to go away for longer periods will be able to arrange with the military authorities for a system of relief parties covering 827 miles within reason.

Farmers wishing to take part of the scheme should contact the central Board of Agriculture or their respective district officers or if they prefer, any of the 100 military officers who are available to write to P.O. Box 4006, Nairobi.

In a statement to the East African Standard yesterday, an official of the Board of Agriculture stressed that farmers need not expect these military caretakers to have any farming experience.

Their main function is to see that the land is cultivated and stock protected to the best possible advantage by terrorists.

Transport need

Farmers who apply for assistance will be told that the guards can be collected and sent to any place where they are required to provide transport or rail fare for their collection and delivery to their farms.

The farmer will be expected also to provide food and accommodation in addition to granting a bonus of 100/- per week to be divided among the guards.

The military authorities have pointed out that they cannot accept any claim for damage done by military animals, nor any arrangements, and farmers will be asked to sign an undertaking to this effect.





CONTROL OF MEAT AND VEGETABLES

Increase in prices not expected

HOUSEWORKS ASSURED OF GOOD SUPPLIES

THE decontrol of meat and vegetables in Kenya, announced on Tuesday, gives the Colony's housewives a chance to lower their bills—if they are prepared to buy selectively.

Traders are emphatic that prices will not rise; some expect them to fall slightly. The president of Wholesale Grocers' Association, Mr. M. Z. Malik, said: "Supplies are good and while the farmers know their prices are no longer controlled it is likely they will bring in more produce. Prices cannot go up."

"Price controls have been lifted only more effectively organised, but a leading member of the trade stated: "We cannot afford to let prices rise—our wholesale costs are still fixed by the Meat Commission and prices are, if anything, too high now."

The city's markets have been lifted also from sets like imported fruit; milk; fishing nets; hard-currency motor vehicles; hard fibre products from Sisal Products (E.A.), Ltd.; rubber sheets and expanded metal; hard-currency agricultural plant and implements; weighing machines; hair dress salons; different types of wiring; and hair-dressing for male Africans.

Flight items are still controlled. They are: cement, charcoal, wood fuel, which is in short supply, and sugar. It is hoped to free cement by the end of the year when the Mombasa Harbour Factory increases supplies. Charcoal and wood fuel remain controlled largely because of the periodic shortages which occur in the main trading centres.
