BOON OF SUBMARINE DISASTER.

Commanding Officer Tried by Court Martial.

SENTENCE OF DIMINISHAL REVERSED.

Admiralty Satisfied with Severe Reprimand.

London, Dec. 1. The sentence of dismissal from his ship and a severe reprimand, passed on Lord Campbell John Hugh Lewis by a Court Martial at Devonport following on the explosion of the submarine flotilla 520 on October 25, has been reversed by the Admiralty. A severe reprimand in respect of the navigational faults, and he will be appointed to command the 125 from the date of the Court Martial. The Admiralty is satisfied that he was not responsible for the explosion.

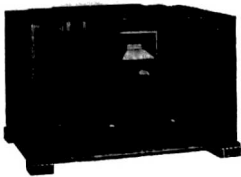

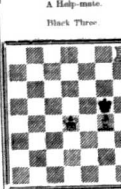

A Half-Move. Black Three.

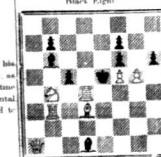


White Three.

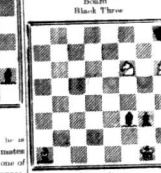

From all accounts these activities start with some secret society, the members of which are always very suspicious of outsiders and are very cunning.

A SUCCESSFUL CHRISTMAS.

Christmas Eve Horror Near Paris.

EXPRESS COLLIDES WITH STATIONARY TRAIN.

Over 200 Killed.

ACCIDENT ATTRIBUTED TO FOG AND FROST.

One of the worst train disasters in history occurred near Paris on Christmas Eve. There are over 200 people dead and 300 injured, the latter including 100 seriously injured.

The accident occurred in a fog when an express dished into a stationary passenger train.

By the narrow margin the disaster was prevented from being even worse, as the express passed the danger signals and being pulled up only a hundred yards from the wreckage of the other trains.

The scene of the disaster is described as being worse than any battlefield of the Great War.

Paris, December 24. A hundred people were killed in a collision at Lezay, near Paris, between two trains which were held up by Christmas holidays.

It is confirmed that there are a hundred dead as the result of the rail smash and there are many injured including two Deputies.

The death toll in the Lezay disaster continues to mount and it is now certain that it will reach 200. One authoritative figure reckons 217 up to the present. As many as a hundred out of the 300 injured people are in a very serious condition.

The scene of the disaster put the word of the war scenes into the minds of people as they viewed the wreckage. The wreckage of the train was composed of wooden coaches whereas the redlining train consisted of steel coaches and crumpled almost totally.

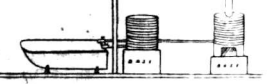
