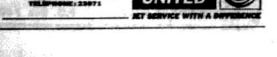

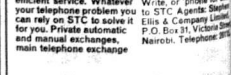

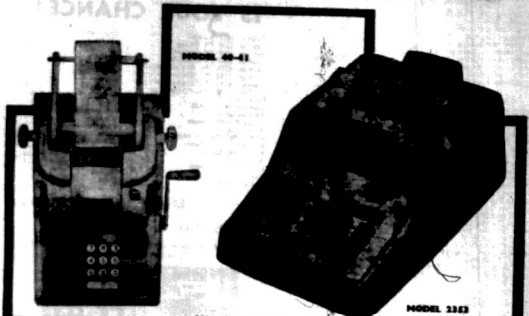

UGANDA RUSH FOR SMALLPOX VACCINATION

Smallpox epidemic spreading through Uganda has been checked by a rush for immunisation that reached 25,000 people here in the first week of the campaign. 130 discharged prisoners called on the Kenya Prisoners' Aid Committee during the past year. Speaking at the committee's monthly meeting last evening, the Attorney-General, Mr. Njoro, said he had not solved every problem, but it had proved as a clearing house for new dignified and better jobs.

Mr. Njoro, who was re-elected president of the association, said that regular employment had been provided for 130 men; more than 30 others were helped to return to their homes; about 770 were paid children's school fees in a dozen cases; and in other cases men were provided with accommodation and clothing.

"It remains true, of course, that the association can give material aid only to a limited degree. Always, there are heavy calls on our strictly limited funds," he said. The association has found this year that discharged prisoners were more ready than before to appreciate the problems of existing employment and the restricted nature of urban opportunities for unskilled men.

"It has been encouraging to us that so many of them were ready to return and make the best of developing districts in their own districts. Development advisory committees should bring about the necessary co-ordination between Government officers, businessmen, industrialists, and the public.

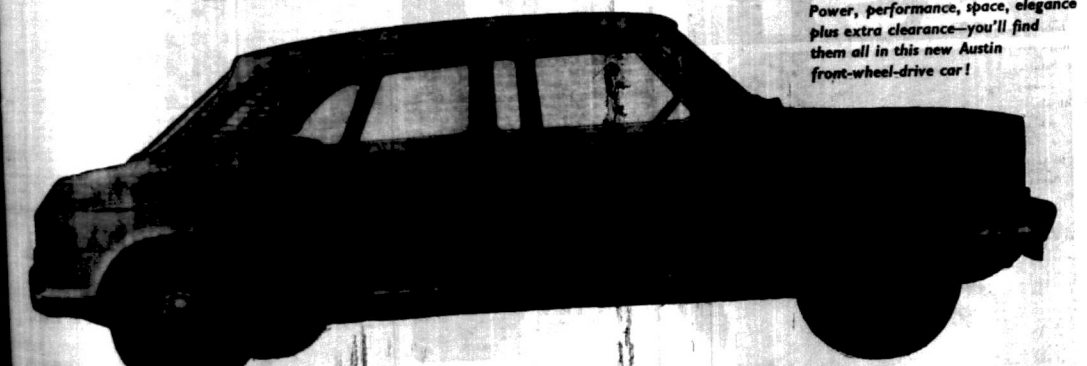

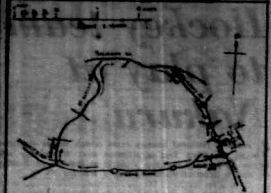
