KENYA MEN TO STUDY IN AMERICA

Grants for educationists and research director

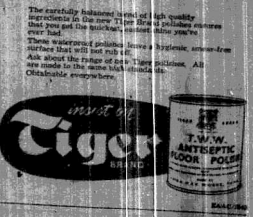

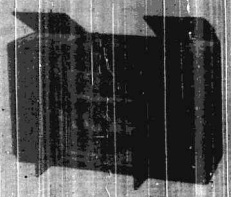
