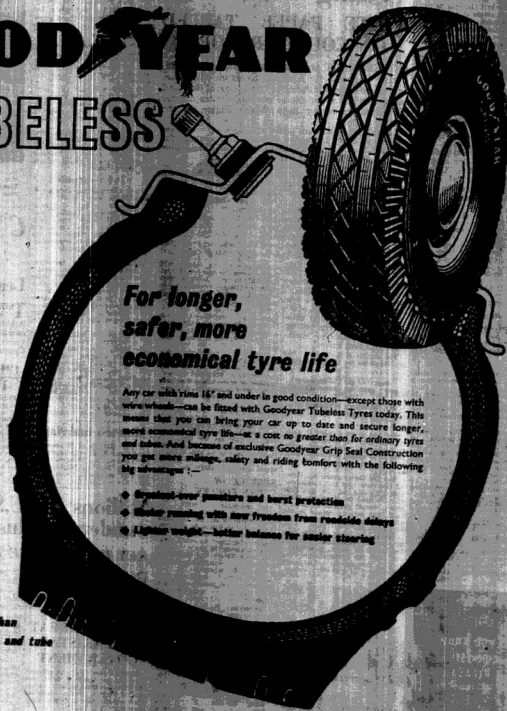

Washington, Jan. 13.—The West today called for a warning to Israel if the United Nations Security Council fails to take further measures to bring about a settlement of the Arab-Israeli dispute.

The warning is incorporated in a draft resolution by the three Western Powers, issued during the debate on Syria's complaint against Israel about the clash on the shores of Lake Tiberias on December 11, in which 50 Syrians and six Israelis were killed.

The British delegate, Sir Peter Dixon, said, "I shall not elaborate on what would have to be done once it is my hope and expectation that the Government of Israel will see to it that this situation does not arise."

But, he said, "If the Government of Israel is unwilling to accept the terms of the Charter, the Security Council will have to take such steps as may be necessary to bring about a settlement of the Arab-Israeli dispute."

The draft resolution, originally drafted by Britain, termed the attack "outrageous and gave warning of the application of economic sanctions under the terms of the Charter."

The Soviet Union, which abstained from voting on the draft, said it would support the resolution if it was adopted.

The United States, which also abstained, said it would support the resolution if it was adopted.

The draft resolution, which was adopted by a vote of 14 to 0 with 4 abstentions, called for a cease-fire and for the withdrawal of Israeli forces from the West Bank and Gaza Strip.

Increase in East African civil aviation

TERRITORY PUBLISHES IDENTITY CARD BILL

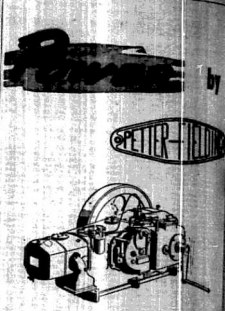

MILITARY AID FOR FREE WORLD 'NOT ENOUGH'

New programmes of economic aid, aimed at helping poorer nations to maintain defence forces, raised to strengthen national defence programmes, were proposed yesterday by President Eisenhower in his Budget message to Congress. The United States Government intends to spend in all its Asia and Europe countries, it is estimated, about \$1,749,000,000 to build up resistance to Communism and supporting military forces of these countries.

The President says, however, that military assistance is not enough for countries which are not economically developed. Development of military strength as a deterrent to aggression is only one part of the challenge. The extra assistance is for the purpose of defence.

The greater expenditure on defence, Mr. Eisenhower says, is due to the failure of Russian leaders to carry out their plan of disarmament that he has proposed. In a speech in New York, Mr. Eisenhower said that American policy was to continue strong support for the free world against the threat of Communism.

Administration spokesmen have already made it clear that this increase in revenue caused by the country's present prosperity will not be used to fund the proposed defence programme. The President's proposals for increased military spending during the past three years will not be reduced, he said. He said that the country's tax system is being studied by the Treasury Department and that the President would propose any changes that might be necessary to provide for the additional revenue required.

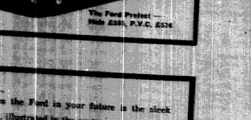

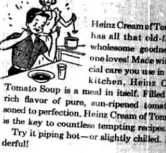

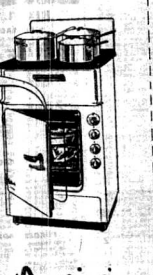
