Mr. Heathcote Amey replied that, since the end of August, the import of maize was a matter for private importers, who were very well able to judge their requirements. He said he understood, however, that substantial quantities from South Africa were being imported.

SIR ANTHONY EDEN, addressing the Senate in Washington, put before Britain and the United States the choice between armed peace, possession, or would soon possess, the means to annihilate each other, would be the world, then, in a few years, to shoot itself to destruction at long range?

He urged the two nations to "face and examine" such questions together, in view of the threat not only of atomic and hydrogen bombs, but of new weapons including guided missiles and rockets which had brought new guided destruction to mankind.

Mr. Eden said that the Western world could take no advantage of aggression and victim alike. "I wish," he said, "that all possibility of world conflict is excluded. The direct danger is reduced but indirect threat remains and its consequences can equally be mortal."

Reviewing what steps the Western world could take in answer to Russia, Sir Anthony said: "We know that we can neither hold Communism nor beat it back by all kinds of arms alone. Friendship and freedom help, but only when used in a rising standard of life—these are what we need."

The British Prime Minister faced a packed Senate and later addressed an equally full House of Representatives. Both Chambers gave him standing ovations and for a long time Senators queued to shake hands with the British leader.

Mr. Eden said that Soviet Russia had been "driven to Europe" and "now lies wayward and unpredictable" between the Kremlin shores north into the vast steppes and into Asia a mixture of "wilderness and waste."

He said that the United States had "a host of individuals" who "constantly" urged the Western world to "take a hard line."

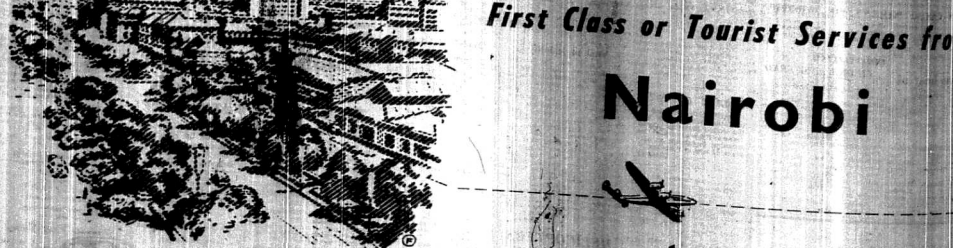

ices a boost to coffee industry

HOPE OF RECORD CROP OFF REDUCED ACREAGE

KEVESA's coffee growers who are producing this season's estimated record crop are doing so from about half the acreage that they used in their previous record total of 18,000 tons.

These figures illustrate the remarkable progress that has been made in the coffee industry during the intervening years. The increase is due primarily to the high prices of recent years which have encouraged planters to grow coffee more efficiently.

Not an even bigger factor has been the extensive use of knowledge of the many-sidedness of coffee growing that has been gained during the past few years.

The centre of all the technical work is the Kenya Coffee Research Station at Kericho, which is responsible for finding out what is the best way to grow coffee in the coffee belt of the Department of Agriculture, Nairobi.

Experimental facets

Here, trained scientists experiment to find out all they can about different varieties of coffee, and the best methods to deal with diseases and pests. They also experiment with fertilizing, laws of conservation of water, and other factors which may affect the yield of coffee growing that they are doing.

They do this not only for the benefit of the coffee industry, but also for the benefit of the general public.

The research station consists of two main sections—Kericho, which was bought in 1946, and Kisumu, which was bought in 1946 and 1947. The station has a total of 500 acres.
