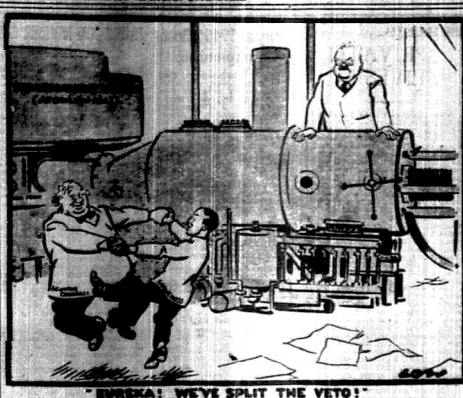

The question of Coast roads, Sir Gilbert continued, was a matter which had been occupying the attention of the Central Roads and Transport Board, and he hoped a substantial sum of money would be earmarked out of the £400,000 that had been recommended for main trunk roads in the 1946-47 financial year.

Mr. Pardi had also referred to the Honorable Members' Committee Report, and he suggested that if the Council were to set in motion a plan, Honorable Members might be able to obtain a better idea of what had gone on at the Coast, and what should be done. "If the idea of this Committee looking at the coast of Mombasa would commend itself to Honorable Members I am sure a Government will do its best to make the necessary arrangements," the Chief Secretary announced.

DADA, he continued, had every intention of making use of ex-servicemen, and he had a great deal of sympathy with Mr. Math's point that the Africans should get training and occupation when he deservied it. 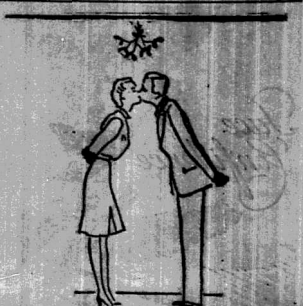

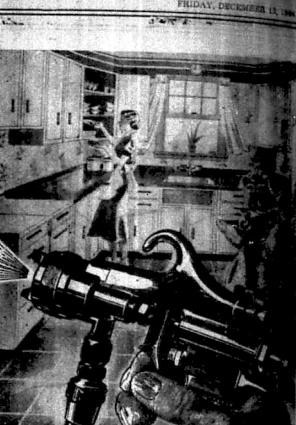

**Minimum Wages Recommendations**

The Nairu Minimum Wage Advisory Board, appointed by the Government, has recommended that the minimum wage for Nairobi should be increased to 1/6 per hour, with a maximum deduction of 1/2 a month, and a further deduction of 1/2 a month where a diet is allowed.


