BRITAIN and the United States are willing to inform the United Nations in advance of nuclear tests and permit international observers if the Soviet Union will do the same.

The two countries have agreed in principle that, in the interests of mutual defence and mutual economy, certain guided missiles will be made available by the United States for use by British forces. These will include intermediate range rockets and intercontinental ballistic missiles.

These are the two main points in a communiqué issued yesterday by President Eisenhower and the British Prime Minister, Mr. Macmillan, at the end of their talks in Bermuda. The communiqué also recorded the decision of the United States to join the Military Committee of the Baghdad Pact.

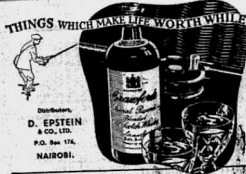

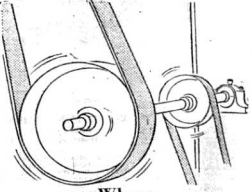

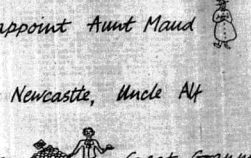
